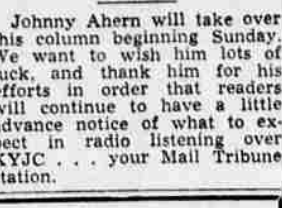

Church Reports Boom In Rural Districts

Philadelphia--(U.P.)--It isn't so that rural congregations are declining and that some country pastors still lead a "horse and buggy days" existence, at least not in the United Lutheran church in America.

According to a church survey, its rural membership is up 73 per cent and more than 9 per cent of the country ministers enjoy electricity and most of the other facilities of city dwelling pastors.

Based on a survey taken in 1,300 rural congregations, the figures also showed that most of the country pastors serve more than a congregation. On the average, each of the church's rural ministers drives his automobile 11,000 miles a year, covering a territory of about 123 square miles.

More than half have a rural background. Their salaries, the survey showed, range from \$1,600 to more than \$3,200 annually.
