Period of Briefs in Aluminum Plant Suit

Portland, Ore., May 10—(U.P.) The \$3,690,000 aluminum plant fumes damage suit by 20 Washington and Oregon farmers and orchardists today entered a possible 40-day period of briefs and answers by defense and plaintiff attorneys.

The suit ended yesterday in the U. S. district court of Judge James Alger Fee after 11 days of testimony and arguments between the plaintiffs and the Reynolds metals company of Troutdale, Ore.

The plaintiffs contend the fumes damaged their crops and

endangered lives of their cattle. Defense Attorney Bordon Wood was given 20 days to file a brief and James C. Dezenford, plaintiff's attorney, was given 20 days to answer.
