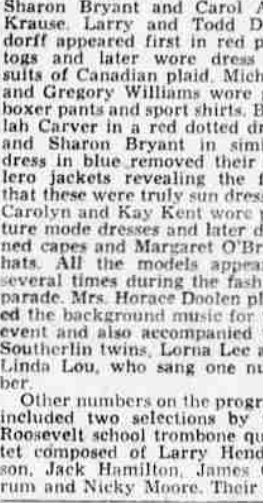
Child's Fashion Show At Methodist Church Is Successful Event

As A Candidate Against U. S. Sen. Wayne Morse HOOVER IS NOW PARADING AS "A REAL REPUBLICAN"

Who Is the "Real Republican"? Dave Hoover's claim to the title of "real republican" is under some challenge. On this page appears a certified copy of Hoover's registration record in California. He registered in 1939 in Los Angeles county but refused to give any party affiliation. The clerk accordingly filled in the party blank thus: "Declines to state."

Dave Hoover "Real Republican?" Since When?

STATEMENT OF TRANSFER OR CHANGE OF NAME I last registered under the name of... ORIGINAL AFFIDAVIT OF REGISTRATION. The undersigned affiant, being duly sworn, says: I will be at least twenty-one years of age at the time of the next succeeding election, a citizen of the United States ninety days prior thereto, and a resident of the State one year of the County ninety days, and of the Precinct forty days next preceding such election, and will be an elector of this County at the next succeeding election.

Above is a reproduction of a certified copy of the registration record in Los Angeles county, California, of Dave Hoover, Lane county dairyman, a candidate for the republican nomination for U. S. Senator, who is advertised as a "Real Republican." This shows on the blank for party affiliation that Hoover "DECLINES TO STATE" his party. Hoover moved to Oregon in 1942.
