**IMPROVEMENT ORDINANCE
DECLARATION OF INTENT—SET
BACK FOR HEARD**

Nature of Improvement: Sanitary Sewer.

Location: Mt. Pitt Avenue.
From: South Peach Street.
To: Hamilton Street.
Date: April 27, 1950.

ORDINANCE NO. 4737.

AN ORDINANCE providing for the construction of an 8 inch Sanitary Sewer line on Mt. Pitt Avenue from South Peach Street to Hamilton Street in the City of Medford, Oregon, and for the assessment of the cost thereof on adjacent property; providing for a meeting of the Council of the City of Medford, Oregon, to consider protests against said improvement and providing for the service of the owners of adjacent property with notice of the assessment of the cost thereof.

THE CITY OF MEDFORD DOTH
ORDINANCE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it is the intention of the City Council of the City of said Sanitary Sewer line on Mt. Pitt Avenue from South Peach Street to Hamilton Street to be constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in the office of the City Superintendent of the construction of said improvement, and that the City of Medford, Oregon, to which plans and specifications reference is hereby made for details and estimated cost thereof, and to assess upon each lot affected by such improvement its proportionate share of the cost of said improvement as provided by the Charter of the City of Medford.

Section 2. That the Council will meet on the 6th day of June, 1950, at 10 o'clock a. m. at which time and place the owners of said adjacent property are hereby called upon to appear before said Council and show cause, if any, why said improvement should not be constructed, and why said property should not be assessed for the construction thereof.

Section 3. The City Recorder is hereby directed to serve notice hereof upon the property owners aforesaid, by publishing this Ordinance in a daily newspaper, printed and published at Medford, Oregon, on said City at least ten (10) days before the date of said meeting, and by depositing five copies of this Ordinance with the City Clerk and conspicuously placing in said City for a period of ten (10) days prior to said meeting, copies of this Ordinance, as designated by me in open session in an authentication of its passage this 16th day of May, 1950.
