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Multnomah Offers To Lease Hospital

Portland, Ore., May 27—(U.P.) The seriousness of Multnomah County's financial situation due to voter rejection of the May 19 \$2,422,244 tax levy was demonstrated today by a county offer to lease to the state the new tuberculosis hospital for \$1 a year—or \$1 for ten years.

The offer was made by County Commission Chairman M. James Cleason. Failure of the tax levy to meet the public's approval may mean the hospital will have to close its doors to 28 current patients in order to meet the budget. Commissioner Frank L. Shull said the state could not operate the hospital several years ago because it said it did not have the needed personnel. "Now it is pleading lack of room," Shull said, "and we will make the room available and let the state assume its responsibility."
