

Rogues Vs. Redding Tonight And Thursday, Fairgrounds

The Medford Rogues and the Redding Browns led by the popular Manager Ray Perry will try to get back into the Far West league results column tonight and Thursday evening at the Fairgrounds park with single games both times at 7:45.

Last night's get-together was postponed about 7:30 because of cold weather. The field was in fair condition and could have been played on, but Managers Tommy Nelson and Perry with local club officials decided to postpone it.

The game probably will be made part of a doubleheader the next time the Browns are in Medford late in July.

Rogues Gain a Bit
Defeat of the Klamath Falls, second in the standings, and of Pittsburg which had been tied with the Rogues for fourth spot, allowed the local club to gain a half game on both Medford now is in sole possession of fourth place, a half game ahead of the Diamonds.

Weather permitting, Jack Lloyd probably will be on the mound for the Rogues tonight opposed by Pat Gosney who is said to have a no wins and one defeat for the Browns.

Lloyd racked up a victory for the Rogues last week Friday as he helped defeat the Klamath Falls Gems, the only win the Rogues made in that series.

Cool Weather Seen
The local weather bureau station said this morning that weather tonight probably will continue cool but it thought it would be good enough for baseball. The forecaster said the cloudy conditions were clearing up slowly and expected better weather by Thursday.

While neither Player Manager Nelson nor Business Manager Mel Carpenter would mention any names until the deals were completed, it was learned yesterday that the Rogues have several possibilities for pitching help "on the fire."

Nelson said that "the wires are hot" between here and several sources, indicating the New York Giants with whom the Rogues have a working agreement, may help Medford.
