Glenn Mitchell Retires From Forest Service

Glenn E. Mitchell, formerly supervisor of the Siskiyou national forest, retired from the service May 31 to accept a position as public relations officer for the Washington state game commission, according to an announcement received here this week.

Mitchell was supervisor on the Siskiyou forest from 1931 to 1939 and since that time has served as a game management expert in the northwest regional office of the forest service. He was associated with the forest service for 40 years, most of it spent in Oregon and Washington.
