Albany, N. Y., (U.P.)—The state commerce department says only one American ever was honored with a title by a British king.

For that reason, the department says, there is only one baronial hall in the United States—Johnston Hall at Johnstown, N.Y., in honor of Sir William Johnston, baronet.

"Perhaps to say that (Johnston) was an American is stretching a point, for to the day he died in 1774 he was a loyal subject of the British crown," the department said.

However, he spent his life promoting the interests of his adopted land and his sympathy for it might have enlisted him eventually on the side of rebellion.

Johnston Hall, built in 1762, still stands.
