FROM THREE TO TWENTY YEARS FOR STUPIDITY

From the letters I receive it would seem that some old timers still in practice tell their patients that the ambulant, office, injection treatment of internal piles (hemorrhoids) is "dangerous," "not effective," or "has been wanting," and that the only effective treatment is hospitalization and radical operation.

I told readers virtually the same thing in the early days of this column. But in 1929 in an article I acclaimed the twentieth century treatment of piles—ambulatory, office, injection treatment, which I had investigated with a good deal of skepticism, I am reminded of this by three letters from readers in widely distant sections of the country who express their satisfaction with the results of injection treatment of piles—one of them having received the treatment nearly twenty years ago. This reader comments: "While I have enjoyed freedom from the old trouble another member of the family has suffered a great deal from the same trouble for more than twenty years—because his doctor still insists that nothing short of an operation in hospital can do any good! Stupidity is right!"

It seems that many victims of internal piles are lured to the operating room by the false notion that piles (hemorrhoids) are "growths" and hence must be "removed." Are varicose veins "growths"? Of course not. Piles (hemorrhoids) are of the same nature—weakness and swelling or overdistension of veins in the lower rectal wall, from prolonged stagnation of blood in the veins.

Once the veins become varicose in the legs, in the rectum or elsewhere, the condition is likely to be permanent, although the victim may have only mild dis-

comfort or annoyance from the trouble ordinarily.

It is only when the piles become inflamed or bleed freely or become extruded and strangulated that the victim suffers an "attack" of piles—becomes acutely aware of the presence of piles. When the inflammation subsides or the excessive bleeding stops for a while or thrombosis (clotting) occurs and nature eventually heals or obliterates that particular pile, there follows an interval of comparative comfort. Too often the poor ignorant victim attributes this spurious "cure" to whatever nostrum he happened to "try" at the time.

Although the immediate pain, bleeding, thrombosis or other manifestation of an "attack" of piles may come from one particular point and treatment should be applied first to that point, the overdistended, swollen, weakened state of the veins is almost always multiple—that is, obliteration or removal of the one vein that is the seat of the immediate trouble will not give any prolonged relief. It is usually necessary to obliterate (by injection treatment) preferably several of the affected veins (piles) at successive intervals, if lasting relief is to be obtained.

Whether the victim of piles chooses the painless and non-disabling office injection treatment or the atrocious, hospitalizing old Spanish custom, this fact should be clearly understood: It is not within human power to guarantee or promise that the victim will never again have piles. He or she is liable to suffer from piles in the future as is any one else, if he continues to commit the sins and errors of hygiene that causes venous stagnation.
