Your Health and Its Care

THE SO-CALLED CHANGE DOES NOT IMPAIR HEALTH

Two Rochester, N. Y., physicians recently reported the results they obtained from microscopic examinations of material taken from the lining of the neck of the womb in 200 consecutive gynecologic patients—women with one or another disorder of the pelvic organs.

These microscopic examinations made in the physician's office, revealed six cases of carcinoma (cancer), three of which were scarcely suspected until the typical cancer cells were found under the microscope.

That's early diagnosis! Upon early diagnosis rests the best hope of cure.

Even though this microscopic examination, as part of the routine examination of a woman at forty, may be "negative" so far as finding cancer cells goes it may nevertheless give information of value to the physician in endocrine (ductless gland) treatment, in irregularities of functional bleeding, in sterility and other conditions.

The Rochester physicians acknowledge that this microscopic test is by no means conclusive by itself. However, they suggest, if it is used to corroborate a detailed history and physical examination and not to displace them, it must be considered an additional tool in the discovery of cancer of the womb at the earliest possible stage.

As reported here the other day, among 10,000 women attending university hospital clinics and consulting physicians in private practice for one ailment or another, 250 were "positive" to this test—that is, cancer cells were found. Of these 250 with beginning cancer 105 had not yet noticed any symptoms that would even suggest cancer.

Two hundred fifty out of ten thousand, or twenty-five out of a thousand. These 10,000 tests were made in Georgia. In Boston 3000 women were examined, about 25% of them having gynecologic complaints, and the physicians who made the Boston study found the test may fail to give "positive" proof even though further progress shows that the patient has cancer. On the other hand they record a "false positive" error in 21 out of 2,935 patients—that is, the cells seem under the microscope appeared to be cancer tissue cells but the 21 patients did not have cancer.

From these studies it is clear that the microscopic test is a valuable aid but it cannot be regarded as conclusive. Other findings in the examination must be taken into consideration in the physician's effort to determine whether the patient has cancer or not.

One physician reporting on the microscopic test for cancer of the cervix mentions that "the

cost of detecting a single case of pre-invasive cancer is estimated to be \$120 to \$150. That is what it costs to make the test on 120 to 150 apparently healthy women—which must be done in order to detect the one case of beginning cancer.

Another physician reporting on experience with this microscopic test estimates that each test costs \$1 to \$2.

Anyway it is good common sense, I believe, for every woman, when she hits forty, to tie herself to the doctor's office for a pelvic examination with particular reference to the discovery of cancer of the cervix (neck of womb). The chances are nine out of ten or better that she hasn't and will not eventually have cancer. But professional assurance about it is worth the price.

Particularly so if the woman past forty has any abnormal or unusual bleeding, discharge or odor or any irritation or pain with or between periods or after the menses have ceased.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS
