Around Hollywood

Hollywood—(U.P.)—Most workers in this magic city struggle to get their faces on the silver screen, but prop man Irving Sandler thinks he beats them all. He gets his name into the movies. Sandler works in the property department at a Goldwyn studio, and his name is emblazoned in every Goldwyn movie for millions of picture-goers to see.

In "Wuthering Heights" it popped up on a tombstone. Cary Grant walked by a store window labeled "I. Sandler & Son, rare coins and stamps," in a scene of "The Bishop's Wife." And in "My Foolish Heart," Susan Hayward and Dana Andrews passionately clined before a billboard labeled "Try Sandler's Soft Drink."

By now his trademark is a Hollywood legend.

"Everybody looks for my name in Goldwyn movies," says the white-haired prop man. "The extras come on the set and say, 'Irving, we don't see your name here.' I tell 'em not to worry. I always figure a way to get it in."

Sandler first "starred" his name on the screen back in 1925. He painted a sign, "I. Sandler, buttons, buckles and braids," for a set of a building in "Little Annie Rooney." Usually prop men paint fictitious names on movie signs so they won't be sued for invasion of privacy. Sandler declared it would be easier—more fun—to use his own.

Heard of Trademark

Later he heard of director Alfred Hitchcock's trademark of appearing in his pictures, so Sandler became the Hitchcock of the property men.

A label on a Singer sewing machine in "North Star" became Sandler. In "The Kid From Brooklyn," actors walked down a street labeled, "Sandler Ave." Sandler didn't even work on "The Best Years of Our Lives," but a pal loyally painted on a store window "Sandler & Son, furniture."

Spelled Name Backgrounds

Once director Gregory Ratoff bet the veteran prop man he couldn't sneak his name into "Adam Had Four Sons." But

when the picture was finished, there was a "Reidnis Flower Shop" in one scene—Sandler spelled backwards.

Getting his name into a picture involved considerable skill, says Sandler.

"I read the script and wait for a good spot," he explains. "I pick a scene with a lot of dialogue so it can't be cut, and a close-up so the name will show."

Currently he's plotting how to work his name into Goldwyn's latest, "Hans Christian Andersen." He thinks he may print it on a theatrical bulletin board in a back-stage scene.

"For a while the director, Charles Vidor, said all the signs would be in Danish and I was worried, but they're back in English now," the prop man says.

I STILL LIKE CHEESE

Monday, Jan. 7, the 300-word article released for publication here under the title Cheese is a Good Health Food referred first to the basic, fundamental or model health diet outlined in The 7 Keys to Vite, for which booklet send twenty-five cents and stamped, self-addressed envelope. The second paragraph was as follows:

The menu doesn't specify any particular variety of cheese. Take your choice—as long as it is real cheese and not a fabricated product.

The Public Relations Committee of the Dairy Council of Canada asserts that there is no such thing as "cheese-type food" permitted in Canada although these are common in the United States. The Committee complains that many readers in Canada will interpret my remark as applying to Canadian process cheese.

In the first place, if no such thing as cheese-type food is permitted in Canada, how could my remarks apply to it? In the next place I haven't any idea what Canadian process cheese is, so I could hardly have intended to give Canadian readers a wrong opinion of Canadian process or any other cheese.

Finally, it seems to me that the Public Relations Committee of the Dairy Council of Canada needs a change of spectacles. In the article I said everything good about cheese that I could think of, closing with this:

No other item anywhere near as good to eat better deserves the designation "health food."

Frankly I don't know what "Canadian process cheese" is all cheese and not a mixture, blend, concoction or product fabricated of divers items including a dash of cheese.

I do hope that "Canadian process" means a method or way of making cheese. If it turns out to be just a Canadian twist to the Yankee trick of selling unwary customers a concoction that looks, smells or tastes like cheese, I hope the Public Relations Committee of the National Dairy Council of Canada may be sentenced to eat some of the stuff every day for ninety days. I'm not at all vindictive, but

dammit I like cheese and I have a responsibility to protect the health of readers.

Wonderful

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Striking Longshore Men Ordered Back

Jersey City, N. J.—(U.P.)—More than 2,000 striking longshoremen were ordered back to work at six Jersey City piers Tuesday by Joseph P. Ryan, president of the AFL International Longshoremen's union.
