Josephine County Forest Radio Net To Start March 22

Grants Pass—The new forest radio network in Josephine county should be in operation by March 22, it was announced today by L. L. Simpson, Medford, secretary-manager and forester of the Southern Oregon Conservation and Tree Farm association.

The network, known as Sexton Forest Industrial Communications, is maintained by radio members of the SOCTFA, and is a direct outgrowth of the radio network of lumber and mill firms of the association in Jackson county.

Equipment Arrives

Last of the equipment needed to put the network on the air has arrived, Simpson said. Representatives of the 10 radio member firms in this area will meet Friday, March 14, to discuss final details of the radio operation. There will be a main land station on the summit of Mt. Sexton, north of here, and a dispatcher's office, operating the other station by remote control, at Room 202, 327 S. E. Sixth street, Grants Pass.

With the 25 new units, radios operated by private firms through the association will now total 85, and additional firms have signed up for sets when they become available. The Jackson county radio system practically "blankets" the county, Simpson said, and the Sexton station is designed to make possible short-wave radio communications throughout Josephine county and parts of Douglas to the north and Del Norte to the south.

Douglas Theno, of Siskiyou Timber service, will superintend the radio operation here, and Margaret Feetham will be office manager.
