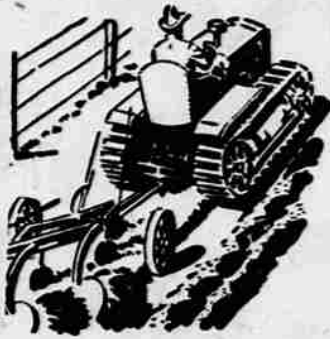


We Salute.... FARM BUREAU Achievements!



- Promoted full development of the Land Grant Colleges, Experiment Stations and Extension Services.
- Farmers have been saved billions of dollars through Farm Bureau action on freight-rate adjustment and legislation assuring fair trade practices on livestock markets and regulating grain exchanges.
- Farm Bureau has backed federal marketing agreements and orders assuring more orderly marketing of dairy products, fruits and vegetables.
- Farm Bureau helped design and pass the Research and Marketing Act as a means of expanding marketing research. Farmers' marketing and purchasing associations have been developed and are being developed with Farm Bureau assistance. All of these are bringing farmers and consumers the advantage of more efficient and less costly marketing.
- Farm Bureau has long fought for the development of new uses for farm products and the diversion of surpluses to useful purposes. Farm Bureaus have consistently supported a sound school lunch program.
- Farm Bureau has consistently backed these measures, designed to promote international trade, world recovery and world peace: Reciprocal Trade Agreements, Economic Co-Operation Administration, Atlantic Charter, International Wheat Agreement, United Nations Charter, Food and Agricultural Organization, International Monetary Fund and Bank.
- Farm Bureau has been unwavering in its support for the principle of parity in the market place. Its accomplishments in this field include: AAA of 1933, Soil Conservation and Domestic Allotment Act (1936), second AAA (1938), legislation establishing and fostering effective operation of the Commodity Credit Corporation, Stagall Act (1941), and the Agricultural Acts of 1948 and 1949. In addition, all major agricultural credit legislation enacted in the last 30 years has received the aggressive support of Farm Bureau.

WHAT IS THE FARM BUREAU?

• The Farm Bureau is a family organization, national in scope, made up of rural people working for the advancement and protection of agriculture. It was developed and is controlled by farmers.

• More than 1,409,000 farm families, people who actually produce the food and fibre of America, speak for themselves through local, county and state Farm Bureaus, and the American Farm Bureau Federation.

• Farm Bureau policies are developed from the desires of farm people as expressed through resolutions democratically adopted at local, county, state and national levels. They are developed on a non-partisan basis and supported on a bi-partisan basis. They represent the combined thinking of Farm Bureau members.

• There are 16,000 local Farm Bureaus, 2,300 county Farm Bureaus, and 47 State Farm Bureaus.

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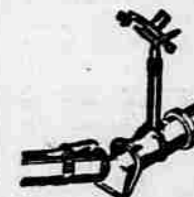
