Your Old Hat Worth \$110 In Big Toronto 'Price War'

Toronto, Ont.—(U.P.)—That old straw hat you nearly threw away last summer is worth \$110 here Friday.

The old broom that has been cluttering up the closet has a value of \$20. And you can get \$200 for the radio that you bought when you were a kid in school.

Not in cash, of course—only if you trade them in and buy a television set or a refrigerator or a vacuum cleaner.

Ridiculous Values
A new kind of "price war" has hit Toronto, and it features what looks like ridiculous trade-in values.

R. T. Barnes, secretary of the Retail Merchants' association, said the idea was to cut the initial down payments on the items involved, thus making it both easier for the customer to buy and for the store to sell.

The Better Plumbing company carried huge advertisements in the papers, giving a trade-in allowance of \$110 "on anything" if you buy a new refrigerator. You can trade in "anything" from an old broom to your old

straw hat or what have you in these sensational "buys" the advertisement said.

\$200 Trade-In Offered
The Mayfair Radio company offered a trade-in allowance of \$200 for "anything" on a combination 17-inch television, radio and 3-speed record player. Company officials said they were accepting mostly old radios.

The State Vacuum Stores, Ltd., advertised a \$20-trade-in value "on your old broom on the purchase of a brand new 1952 model vacuum cleaner."

Japanese Brides Register Deadline Is Next Wednesday

Tokyo.—(U.P.)—The race between love and law headed down the home stretch Friday.

American consular officials issued a "hurry up" reminder to U. S. Army personnel, warning they must register their brides by March 19 if they want to bring them back home.

Law To Expire
Of some 8,000 weddings in Japan involving U. S. service personnel since 1945, nearly 7,000 have been American men taking Japanese wives. Nearly 4,000 of these brides have left Japan for the United States. The reason for the rush is this: U. S. public law 6, which enables members of the armed forces to take Japanese brides to the United States, expires next Wednesday.

Previously Extended
The situation has come up before, but each time a new law has extended the deadline. However, nobody ever knows for sure.

If a GI fails to register his marriage on time, he can either get the U. S. Congress to pass a special law letting him bring his bride home or else he can hope the deadline is extended again.

Substitute Plan Given for Piping Gas to Northwest

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Washington.—(U.P.)—Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corp., Houston, Tex., filed a new plan Thursday with the Federal Power Commission for importing Canadian natural gas into the Pacific Northwest.

Substitute Proposal
The new swapping plan was substituted for Pacific Northwest's earlier proposal to build a 2,175-mile pipeline from Texas to the state of Washington at a cost of \$174,186,000.

The new proposal calls for Pacific Northwest to import 250,000,000 cubic feet of gas daily from Alberta into the state of Washington. About 25,000,000 cubic feet would be returned to Canada at the Washington-Canadian border.

Pacific Northwest also would buy 225,000,000 cubic feet of gas daily from Panhandle Eastern Pipeline Co., Kansas City, at a point near the international boundary near River Rouge, Mich. That gas would be redelivered to Canadian Natural Gas Pipelines, Ltd., for transmission into Ontario and Quebec.

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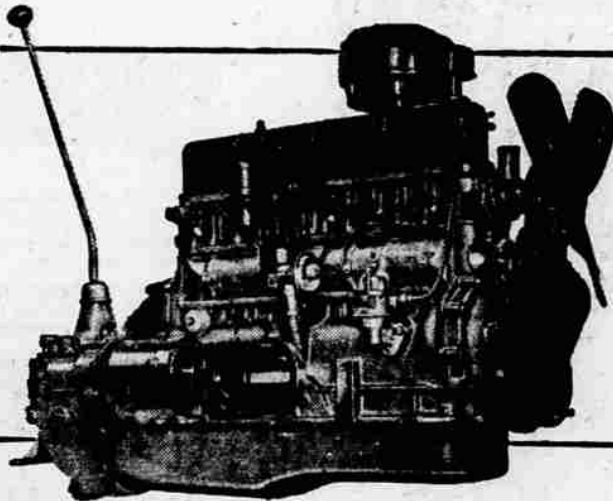
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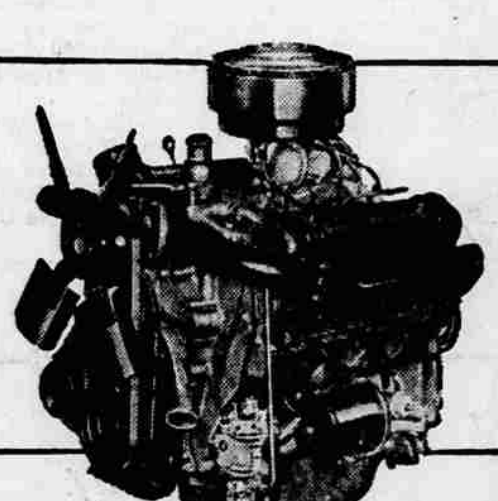
