Portland — (U.P.) — The State highway commission has rescinded its order of February 1 which would have removed service club signs from the outskirts of Oregon communities.

The commission had ordered the signs taken down within six months because it believed they violated state right-of-way laws. But R. H. Baldock, highway engineer, reported such signs are not on state property but are within the city limits of the various communities concerned.

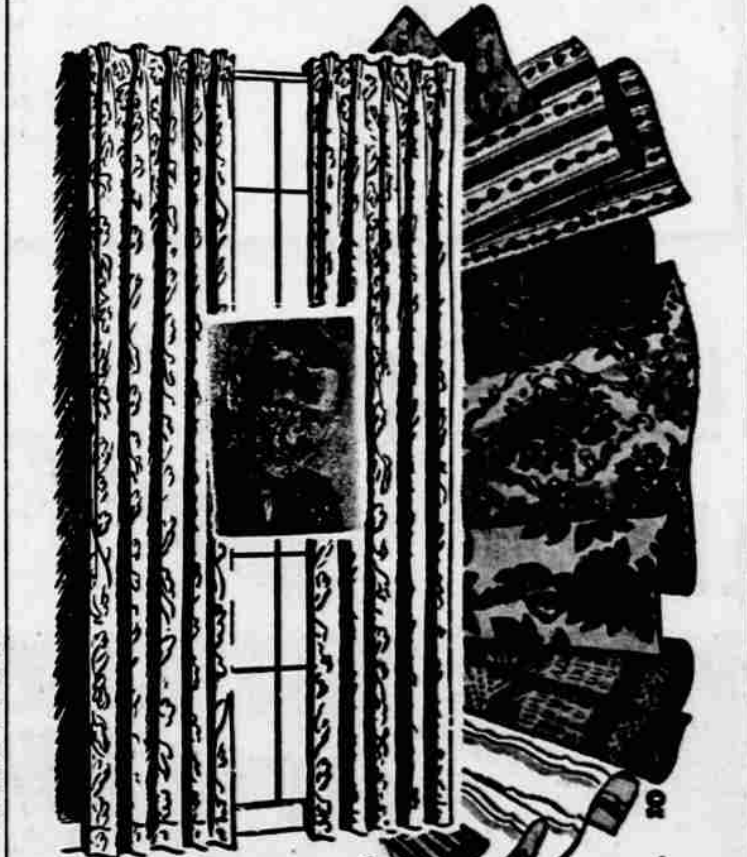

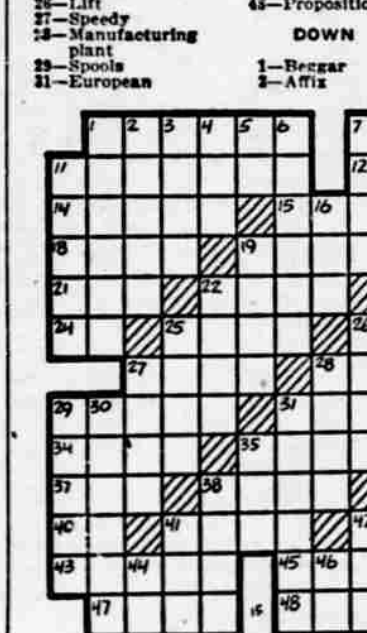

Batista Expected To Be Forced Out

Mexico City — (U.P.) — Exiled Cuban President Carlos Prio Socarras predicts that Cuban public opinion will force Gen. Fulgencio Batista out of power without a counter-revolution.

Prio told the United Press in an interview following his arrival here recently that "everything went wrong" last Monday when he attempted to halt Batista's revolutionary military coup.

"The loyal generals were thrown out and the loyal forces seemed to melt away," Prio said. "Finally I was forced to order

cessation of resistance in order to prevent bloodshed of innocent persons."

Only two persons were killed in the short revolution. They were guards stationed at the presidential palace in Havana.
