Menhaden Catch Exceeds Others

Washington—(U.P.)—"I'll take menhaden" seems to have been the theme song of Atlantic coast fishermen from northern Florida to Long Island lately.

The National Geographic Society reports that 1,500,000,000 menhaden, a catch exceeding that of any other fish species, were hauled out of American waters in 1951. The total is estimated to equal one-fourth of U. S. commercial fishery produce for that year.

The fish, a member of the herring family, is an unpopular one with the American chef. Described as "oily, mealy and bony," the menhaden's chief claim to fame is its oil.

Menhaden oil, manufactured by more than 30 plants set up along the Atlantic coast for its processing, is used in making soap, paint, linoleum, water-proofing compound and in tempering steel. What is left over after oil extraction is ground into farm animal feed and used for fertilizer.

The menhaden is known by many aliases to its marine hunter. It is labeled everything from old-wife, greentail, and pogy to bugfish and whitefish.

About a foot long and weighing three quarters of a pound when fully grown, the menhaden is pursued in specially-built boats ranging from 85 to 150 feet in length. Its favorite habitat is the shallow coastal waters, where it swims close to the surface and in huge, closely massed formations. As many as 500,000 of these fish have been known to be trapped in a single catch.

Tax Money Saved As Engineers Learn Jobs

Washington—(U.P.)—U. S. Army engineers are saving taxpayers thousands of dollars while they learn their job.

The engineers have been using Prince William Park, Virginia, as a practice ground on which they learn bridge and roadbuilding and repairing instead of their own grounds at Fort Belvoir, Va.

The park as a result has received the benefit of new bridges and new roads that otherwise would have been demolished on the grounds of the army post.

This novel and constructive use of army manpower, has given to the park "at least \$400,000 worth of free work from the engineers," according to Conrad L. Wirth, director of the National Park Service.

Blood Cements Unity Among Employees

Lorain, O.—(U.P.)—Life-saving blood serves to cement unity among the 227 employees of the Nelson Stud Welding Co. here.

When the daughter of one of the workers was seriously ill last year, fellow employees volunteered to give their blood in an effort to save her life. The little girl died but the idea didn't.

Almost 90 per cent of the employees are now registered with the Lorain County hospital. When blood is needed, they are advised.

If, during an emergency, the hospital's blood bank becomes depleted, the company "loans" its employees. A credit is established in the Nelson "account," upon which to draw in future emergencies.

MUST WIFE DREAD MEETING OF FATHER AND EX-HUSBAND

(Q) "I've been divorced for 10 years and have three lovely teenage children. I never remarried, hoping that my husband would come back to me. He comes to see the children twice a week. Several years ago, he married a woman young enough to be his daughter and that hurt the children very much. But, that marriage didn't last long because he couldn't keep up with her fast life. My father doesn't know he comes to see the children. I never told him because of his poor health. Now that he can get around a little, he comes to see me often. I am so afraid my father and my ex-husband will meet. I don't want to hurt either of them as I love them both very much and my children would feel terrible, too. Please advise me about what to do."

(A) This is a case where "honesty is the best policy." Make a clean breast of the whole matter to both your father and your ex-husband. Explain to both of them your reason for not telling your father about your ex-husband's visits to your home to see the children and ask both of them to try to be friendly if and when they meet.

It would be perfectly natural for your father to resent the way your husband behaved when he divorced you and married a younger woman. Any father would resent such behavior and would not want to be civil to the man who mistreated his daughter and his grandchildren.

But, there would be nothing to be gained by your father's showing his resentment and much to be lost. If your father insulted your husband or made things unpleasant for him when

you were present, your husband might give up his visits completely. Then your children would be the losers.

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California Storm Moves Into Rockies; 4 Persons Lose Lives

Denver—(U.P.)—A late winter storm that hit southern California with rain, snow and a baby tornado rolled east toward the Rockies Monday on a long north-south front.

The storm, which produced a week-end of bitter weather in the Los Angeles area, was lashing portions of Arizona, Nevada, Wyoming, Utah and western New Mexico with rain and snow. Four persons die.

In southern California, where four persons lost their lives as a result of the combination of blizzards, rain and windstorms, skies were generally clearing.

But the effects of the storm were just beginning to be felt in states to the east.

Ely, Nev., reported 20 inches of snow at 5:30 a.m. There were varying degrees of precipitation. Snow fell in western Wyoming and Utah and snow and rain showers in Arizona. Some rain and snowfall was reported in western New Mexico.

The weather bureau said the storm probably would beat itself out on the western slope of the Rockies in Wyoming, Colorado and New Mexico, although some of its effects probably would be felt in eastern Wyoming.

Utah Roads Open
The snowfall was mostly light over Utah with roads open and no known casualties or suffering.

The California storm was capped by a freak twister that swept through Santa Monica

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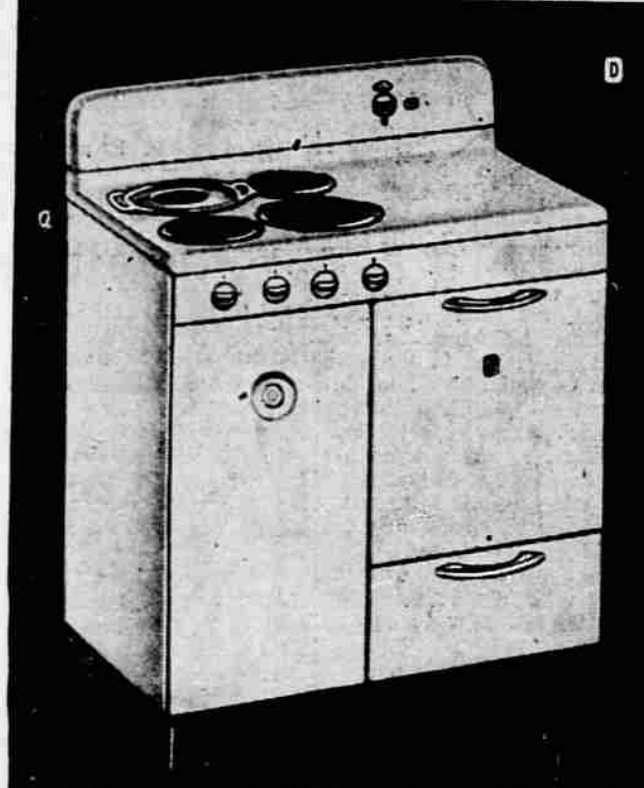
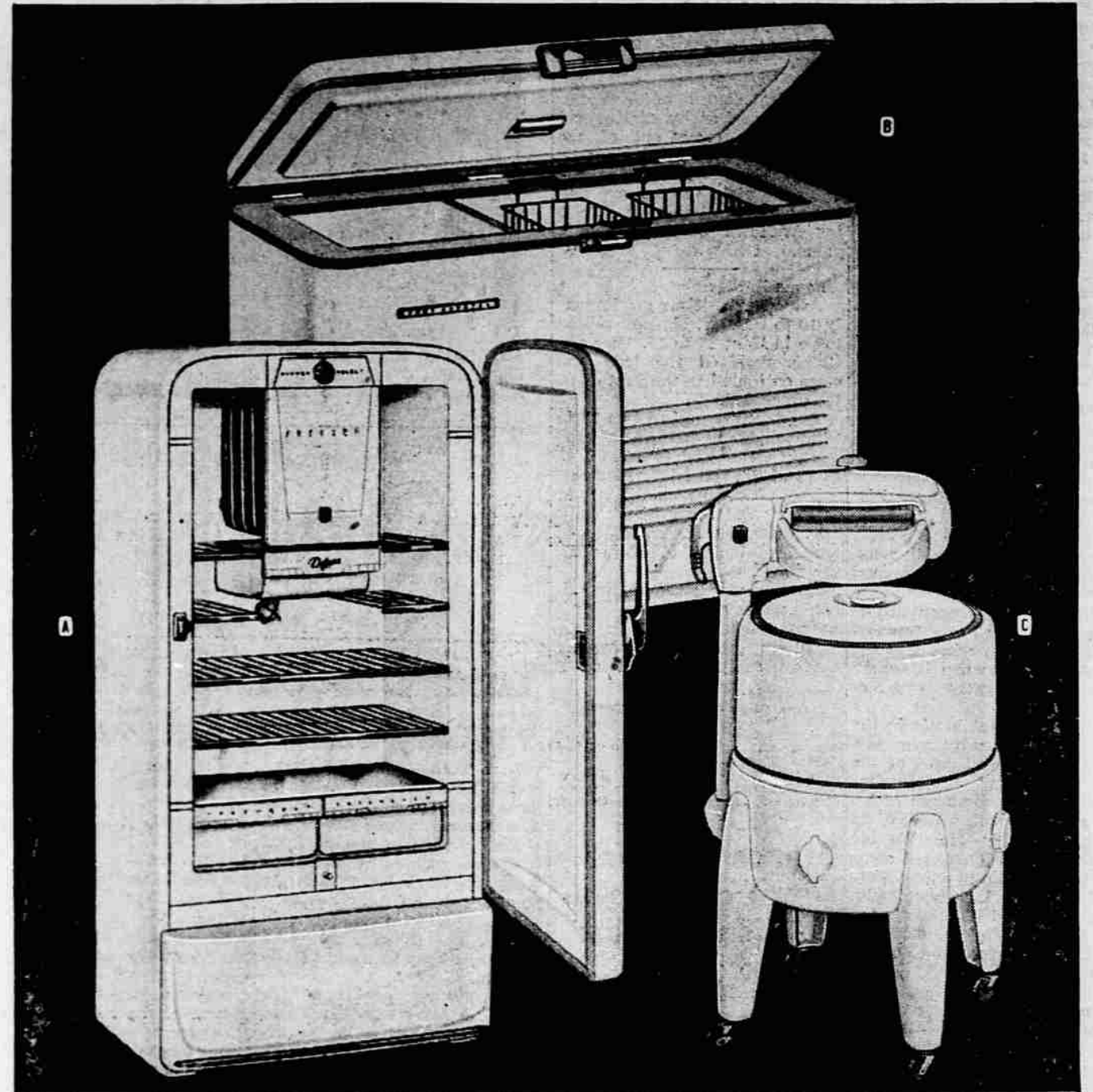
