FOR A LADY WHO WANTS TO BAWL

Just reading your column should cure one of almost anything. I never miss it. I love your irony. (You mean you understand, when I call readers names, that I refer to other readers, not you? Well, thank you, Ma'am. It is good to know they are not all stupid.)

Will your iodine ration do anything for an old lady who gets so tired every hour or two that she just wants to sit down and bawl—or die—makes no difference which? (L. T.)

Well, now, with apologies to Mr. Peewy the delightful drugist on F. McG. and M.'s program, I wouldn't say that. It costs little or nothing to bawl, but the way they have things fixed you have to pay a pretty penny no matter how you die.

Let me see. Fortunately your letter shows that you live in the Great Lakes basin where soil, water and food are poor in iodine. Gazing into my crystal ball I

see a letter from the mother of a 16-year-old girl who had been under the family doctor's treatment for anemia. The anemia was corrected but the girl still suffered from a kind of chronic fatigue which kept her from entering junior college. Finally mother began giving her the iodine ration—as described in the pamphlet The Iodine Ration—available on written request (not a clipping) if you inclose stamped, self-addressed envelope. Later mother reported:

"The result has been simply unbelievable... she was so tired... great lassitude... couldn't enjoy life as other young people do. Now she is bubbling over most of the time..."

I'm a quack, all right, but even so, I do not mean to imply that the Iodine Ration will make everybody in the Great Lakes basin bubble over. I merely contend to wit and as follows:

(a) Every man, woman or child in the country needs a wee, wee bit of iodine daily to maintain good nutrition.

(b) The soil, water and locally grown food in many parts of the country are deficient in iodine.

(c) A daily ration of iodine in the form I suggest in the pam-
