Washington—A.P.—Don't run for the DDT when the mosquitoes start buzzing this summer. You may like it, but the Agriculture Department entomologists said Wednesday that recent tests in Florida and California show that the pests now are "definitely resistant" to DDT, which once was deadly poisonous to them.

chances for resistant mosquitoes to build up rapidly a resistant mosquito population," the entomologists explained.

The experts suggested that the answer may be more dependence on permanent control methods, instead of spraying with insecticides. Permanent methods include draining and filling breeding areas, and stock

They said that while mosquitoes are not yet noticeably resistant to newer insecticides, they may also build up immunity to them if given time. The new poisons include lindane, chlordane and BHC.

The experts pointed out that DDT has been used extensively in the two test areas since it was first available in 1945. The resistance build-up has been gradual but is speeded up when insecticides are used on mosquito larva—that is, by spraying swamps and other breeding grounds.

"When large-scale outdoor control campaigns are directed against mosquitoes in the larva stage, most of the insecticide-susceptible mosquitoes are killed . . . this greatly increases the
