Special Stamp Honors 4-H Program on Anniversary

Washington—(U.P.) The world's largest farm youth organization—the 4-H clubs—was accorded high honor for its 50th anniversary this year.

A new postage stamp commemorating the clubs was issued at Springfield, O., where the idea of farm youth doing something with its head, heart, hands, and health was born.

The 4-H idea spread with such vigor that now there are about 90,000 clubs, with a membership of more than 2,000,000 boys and girls between 10 and 21. In a half century the clubs have trained more than 15,000,000 American youngsters. The organization has been classed as "one of the greatest character-building agencies in the United States."

By act of Congress, 4-H youth training is under the immediate supervision of some 9,000 county extension agents cooperatively employed by the Department of Agriculture, the state colleges of agriculture and county governments. Also 250,000 men and women serve without pay in volunteer guidance to the various types of 4-H club activities.

Many Awards Given

A growing list of corporations and individual donors are contributing to a carefully developed system of awards ranging from scholarships and breeding stock to gold medals and cash prizes. That has resulted in renewed incentive for the young people to take part in many and varied projects and to display their skills in competition with each other at state fairs and 4-H conventions.

The clubs' program provides opportunity to "learn to do by doing," since each new member chooses one or more projects for "basic training." These projects range from the best-known single job, that of raising farm animals for a profit, to other activities such as raising a garden, cooking and nutrition, forestry, soil conservation and many others.

The soil conservation project, for example, is a steady job for the 4-H clubbers, its value fully recognized in recent years.

Important Work Done
From almost every state come reports of 4-H members who have ditched, terraced, laid drain

pipes, seeded old fields to grass, filled up gullies, and built ponds and dams.

Character training is received through demonstration and judging-team work, tours and hikes, work in music appreciation and dramatics, 4-H camps, and exhibits at community, county, state and often interstate events.

Outside of their local interest, the 4-H members have become increasingly conscious of their responsibility in sharing their knowledge with the young people of other lands.

The result has been the International Farm Youth Exchange, in which the youth of the United States and other countries have worked and shared ideas.

HONORED AT LONG LAST
