Army Authorities Question Private Held by Czechs

Frankfurt, Germany — (U.P.) — U. S. Army authorities questioned Pvt. Charles E. Wood Thursday about the three months he was held by Communists in Czechoslovakia.

The State Department announced the release of the Voth, Tex., soldier Wednesday.

Army authorities refused to enlarge upon the announcement, except to say Wood had been turned over to American authorities at an obscure point on the Czech-German border March 29.

Wood disappeared from his unit last December and shortly afterward was reported arrested by the Czechs.

Authorities said that if Wood is found guilty of being absent without leave he will be court-martialed.

Lover of Cats Made Victim of Teenage Extortionist Gang

Houston, Tex. — (U.P.) — A 79-year-old woman whose love for cats has made her the victim of teenage extortionists threatening to kill her pets, hid behind locked doors in her home Thursday.

Salmon To Be Planted In Washington Waters

Seattle — (U.P.) — More than 4,000,000 hatchery-reared chinook salmon will be planted this spring in the Willapa Harbor and Grays Harbor watersheds of southwestern Washington, the State Fisheries department said Thursday.

The fish will be planted in the Chehalis, Willapa, Naselle, Nehalem, Bear, Chinook and Hump-tulips rivers.

In addition, three coastal hatcheries, at Satsop, Willapa and Naselle, are holding more than 1,000,000 brood silvers from last year, part of which will be planted this year and the remainder next spring.

Widow To Marry 'Forgotten Man' Of Iowa Prison

Indianola, Iowa — (U.P.) — A 68-year-old widow said Thursday she would marry the "forgotten man" of the Iowa State Penitentiary "just as soon as the parole board says it's okay."

"I'm tired of living alone," said Mrs. Addie Jackson whose first husband died in 1946.

Ernest (Ole) Lindquist, freed Wednesday on parole, became known as the "forgotten man" after he was sentenced to life imprisonment for the 1909 killing of a Carroll, Ia., policeman and for 40 years never received a single present from the outside.

Mrs. Jackson learned of his story in 1949 and began sending him letters. "I sent him a Christmas card and a dollar," she said, "and he sent back some photographs."

She said she finally got permission to visit him in 1950 and it was "love at first sight."

Botulism Blamed For Death of Two

Portland — (U.P.) — The Oregon State Board of Health said Thursday the deaths of two men last week in Pilot Rock, Ore., have been tentatively diagnosed as due to botulism.

Remnants of the jars of home-canned foods, eaten by Arthur D. Hileman, 72, and his son, Manley, 42, were undergoing tests by Dr. William Levin at the state hygienic laboratory.

The men became ill March 22, the father dying the next day and his son on March 26.

Botulism is caused by poisons, called toxins, secreted by a species of bacteria, Dr. Gordon C. Edwards, acting state health officer, said.

1939 Restaurant Prices Draw Crowds

Detroit — (U.P.) — The customers were still standing in line for seats Thursday at the Green Feather restaurant, which has been charging 1939 prices for the past six months.

Fellow restaurant owners predicted a flash-in-the-pan boom and then a big bust for Joe Tuzack last October when he started selling steak dinners for a dollar, pork chops for 75 cents and hamburger steak dinners for 45 cents. But Tuzack says business is better than ever.
