Although it's supposed to be a closely guarded secret, we happen to know that an honest to goodness flying saucer landed in Walter Leverette's orchard the other day.

Investigators now believe that drinking water containing less than 2 parts per million of fluorine (fluorides) protects the teeth against caries (cavity formation), but more than 2 parts per million may cause mottled enamel.

There is still some controversy between various groups in this country over the wisdom of fluorinating public water supplies when the fluorine naturally present is much less than one part per million.

Senate Committee OKs Foreign Aid Bill

Washington—(U.P.)—The Senate Foreign Relations committee has approved a bill authorizing expenditure to about \$6,900,000,000 for foreign aid.

Chairman Tom Connally (D-Tex.) predicted that the Senate will accept the committee version of the bill. Some Republicans are talking however, of trying to cut it by another \$900,000,000.
