Hysteria is NOT make-believe, malingering, faking or "putting on an act." Although it mimics actual disease -- anything from blindness to paralysis -- well enough to deceive even the physician in some instances, the hysteric himself or herself is deceived as much as any one else.

Hysteria is not "hysterics" -- not an emotional outburst or demonstration calculated to impress or influence anybody. In the sixth edition of his Practice, published in 1906, when Dr. Osler went to Oxford, hysteria is defined as "a state in which ideas control the body and produce morbid changes in its functions (Möbius)." Lest the casual reader draw a wrong inference from this, let me quote a sentence from Dr. Osler's chapter on treatment:

"It is pitiable to think of the misery which has been inflicted on these unhappy victims by the harsh and unjust treatment which has resulted from false views of the nature of the trouble."

After several pipefuls I have concluded not to mention any symptoms of hysteria here. You dumb laymen -- I mean you poor geeks too -- much of such "health education" from their sources. I'm an arrant quack in the estimation of many professional and lay critics, but, be-

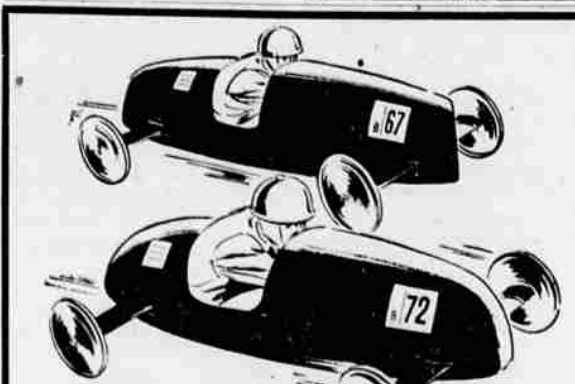
150th Anniversary Better Things for Better Living... through Chemistry

Special Handling for Youthful Violators

Bridgeport, Conn.—(U.P.)—City Court Judge D. Harold Cotter thinks youthful traffic violators need special handling.

The judge has written a special two-page essay, a copy of which is presented to each convicted teen-age motorist. The essay stresses that it's a privilege and an economic asset to be allowed to drive a car.

Cotter explained that too many youths take their licenses "too much for granted" and lose them before they realize their value.

"If we can impress upon the youth of today the importance of his right to operate a motor vehicle," the judge declared, "we have taken a very important step in instilling in him the mature sense of caution which makes a good, careful driver."
