

Portland Gasoline Supply Said Ample

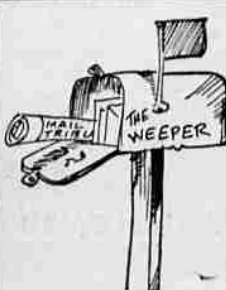
Portland — (U.P.) — Oil distributors here said Friday that gasoline supplies in this area are ample for the normal use and that hoarding is unnecessary. They pointed out that Northwest stocks are supplied by California refineries which have not been affected by the nationwide strike of oil workers.

Southeastern Idaho is the only northwest area where shortages have been noted. It is supplied from Salt Lake City.

The distributors pointed out that their assurance of ample supplies applies to motorists and not to the aviation stocks which are more closely controlled by government orders.

Portland — (U.P.) — The Coos Bay Lumber company has declared a dividend of \$1.50 as of May 22. The dividend is payable June 2.



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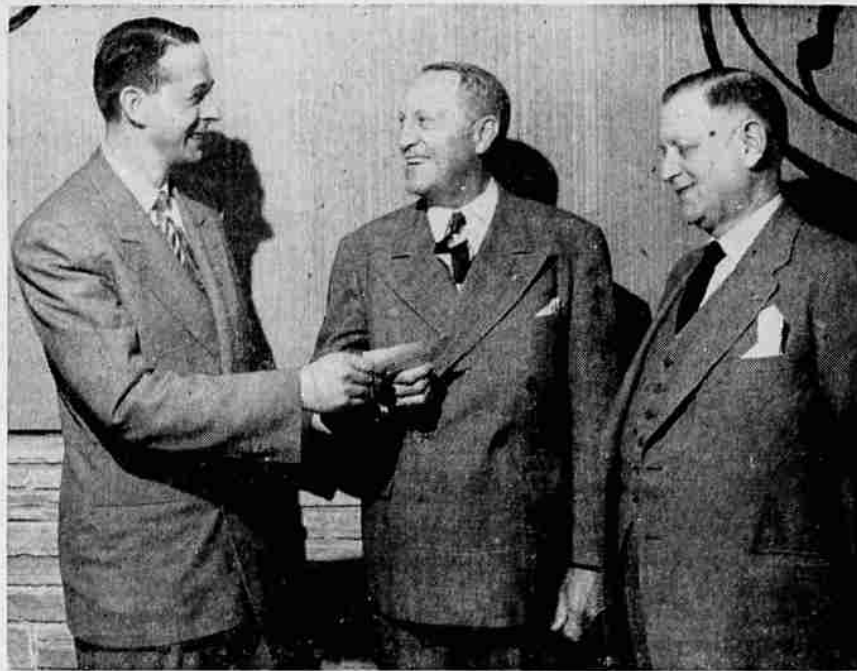
