

Free Schooling Program for Korea Veterans Studied

Washington—(U.P.)—The House Veterans Committee is working toward approval of a free schooling program for Korean war veterans.

Under key provisions of the bill as tentatively approved so far a Korean veteran would get \$110 a month for education if single and \$150 if he had dependents.

Would Make Payments

The veteran would make tuition payments himself, keeping the rest for living expenses. In this respect the measure will differ from the World War II Bill of Rights. Under that legislation, the government sent tuition money direct to the schools.

36 Months Maximum

The new bill as it shaped up in advance of a final committee vote, would provide 1½ days of schooling for each day of Korean service. The maximum would be 36 school months, enough to complete a four-year college course.

Unlike the GI bill for World War II veterans, the new one would not permit free schooling in such things as bartending, dancing, and personality courses.
