Now we know that tonsils are one of our best defenses against disease...

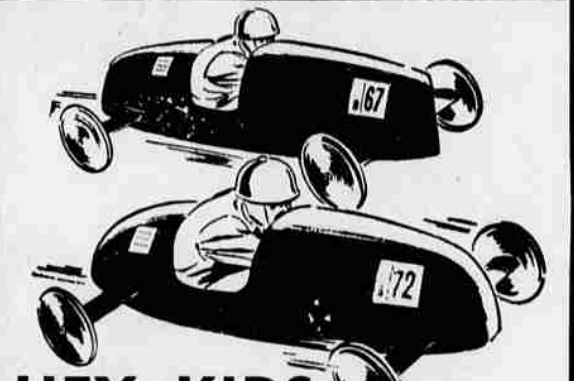
On the whole, tonsils should be left in the throat... (End of Quotation).
