

### Remodeling Done At Groceteria; Reopens Saturday

The Groceteria store at Sixth and Grape streets will reopen at 8:30 a.m. tomorrow after being closed several days for extensive remodeling. Weekdays the store hours are 8:30 a.m. to 9 p.m. and Sundays from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m.

The entire store has been rearranged and new equipment added. Featured are several Friedrich refrigerators, serve-yourself units, including a complete meat self-service department. A recent national survey indicates that 51.90 per cent persons like self-service meats and 48.10 do not, according to "Bill" Gates, president of the Groceteria. To accommodate everyone the store also features a complete counter meat department.

Maurice Boughner is in charge of both sections. Melvin Hall is secretary of the organization and manager of the store.

The drug department now will be in the center of the store and purchases from there will be checked through with other store purchases, and not separately as in the past, Gates said. This, he explained, saves time and effort for the customers.

The new refrigeration service includes added cases in the produce and dairy departments. Featured in all the Friedrich refrigeration additions is "floating air," designed to reduce spoilage and preserve vitamin content. The wrapping room for the self-service meats also is equipped with "floating air."

Albert W. Gandt, valley bonded representative for the Friedrich Refrigerators, Inc., arranged the new refrigeration installations supervised by Tom McKelvey Jr., refrigeration engineer from the San Antonio, Tex., factory.

Shelving increased. Shelving capacity in the store has been increased about 25 per cent and checking stands and shelves are now arranged east and west instead of north and south as before.

Prepared dinners to take out by the plate soon will be a specialty of the store from a self-service refrigerator unit. Gates added. These dinners will be designed for groups, families or

### U. S. Savings Bond Sales Holding Steady

Purchase of defense savings bonds in Jackson county are holding fairly steady—neither rising nor declining—it was reported today by Morris B. Leonard Sr., county chairman for the sale of U.S. bonds.

During April, \$36,000 in E bonds were sold in the county for a total of \$190,256 so far this year, Leonard said.

Throughout the state, the trend in sales also is steady, he said, with \$1,550,387 in Series E bonds sold in April, for a total of \$7,129,076 for the first four months of 1952.

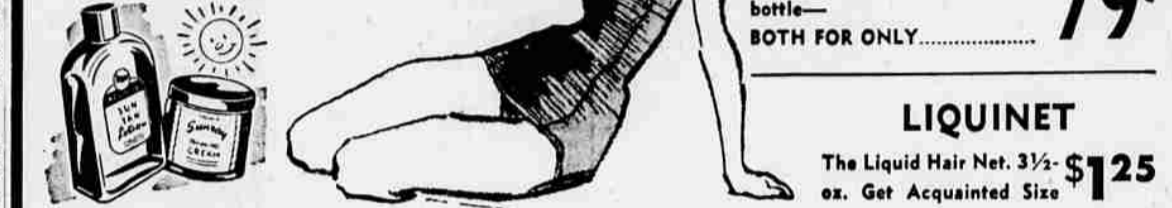
