THE HARDEST WATER IS SOFTER THAN MILK

One out of every 922 letters from readers is a query concerning the effects of drinking hard water.

Hardness in drinking water is due to presence of calcium and magnesium salts. The degree of hardness is measured or recorded in parts per million or grains per gallon of calcium carbonate.

Any one who imagines the calcium (lime) in water that is at all hard may be "deposited" in the arteries, kidneys or joints if one continues long enough using the water as drinking water may find this fact reassuring.

There is more lime in a glass of milk than in a gallon of hard water. The lime (calcium) in milk, however, is absorbed, assimilated and used by the body—and indeed milk is the best source of food calcium for the body, which requires not less than 10 to 15 grains of calcium daily for maintaining health and functional efficiency.

Rain water, snow water or distilled water is as wholesome or healthful to drink as tap water, well water or spring water, if you have to drink it or prefer to drink it.

I do not hold with the notion that everybody should drink not less than so many glasses of water every day. It would take a better doctor or health expert than I am to make me drink a thimbleful of water I didn't want. I believe my own metabolism and natural thirst tells me how much water to drink.

Barkley 6th Entrant in Democratic Race

Washington—(U.P.)—Vice-president Alben W. Barkley's formal entry into the presidential race gave the Democrats six announced candidates for their free-for-all national convention.

First ballot votes also will be cast at Chicago for several favorite son candidates. The 1,230 votes will be so divided at the outset that no candidate will have more than about a fourth of the total. Many Democrats believe a deadlock is a serious prospect.

With Barkley announcing that he will not actively seek the nomination, his friends regard him as a strong compromise possibility who could benefit from a stalemate.
