CALCIUM CLICKS WITH VITAMIN D

So far as the prevention or correction of any of the numerous common complaints due to calcium deficiency is concerned it is generally a advisable to take vitamin D along with whatever calcium preparation or high-calcium food you may take to remedy the complaint.

When calcium deficiency manifests itself in the form of some familiar chronic complaint or not, one might get all the calcium one requires just by consuming daily a larger than ordinary proportion of high-calcium foods, such as milk, cheese, eggs, peas, beans, nuts and peanuts.
