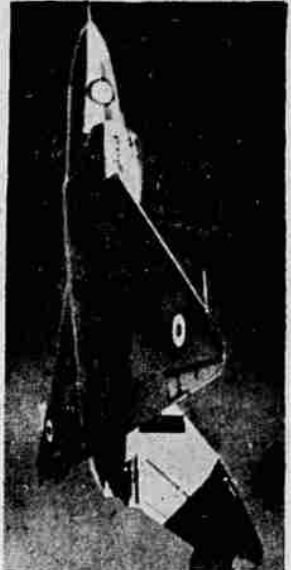


### Violent Quake Jars Argentina, Chile

Buenos Aires —(U.P.)— A violent earthquake shook a wide area of Western Argentina and Chile Tuesday night. It was felt as far east as Buenos Aires and La Plata. Police reported at least one person killed. There were no immediate reports of property damage. The epicenter was placed between the Western Argentine

towns of Media Agua and Carpinteria, about 30 miles south of San Juan city where an estimated 10,000 persons died in a 1944 earthquake.

### Three Main Proposals May Stir Up Debate At Grange Convention

La Grande —(U.P.)— At least three proposed resolutions were expected to stir up a ruckus Wednesday at the annual meeting of the Oregon State Grange. The hot debate was expected to come on a resolution asking for a state law requiring an anti-Communist loyalty oath of all officers and teachers of the state's public schools; resolutions both for and against construction of the Pelton dam on the Deschutes river, and a proposed big truck taxation bill.

**Membership Drops**  
In other business, State Secretary Bertha Beck reported membership in the state at 29,938, a drop of about 500 from last year. She suggested that officers do something to remedy the declining membership.

Phyllis Mast, McKinley; Marilyn Reihner, North Bend, and Irene Kolmayer, Skyline Grange of Portland, were announced as winners in the state Juvenile Grange declamatory contest. In adopting the report of an interim committee that has spent a year studying the tax problem, the grange turned down a sales tax without a dissenting vote.

### Katherine Brush, Novelist, Passes

New York —(U.P.)— Katherine Brush, 49, novelist and short story writer, died Tuesday in St. Luke's hospital. She had been ill for several months.

Mrs. Brush, who began her career as a reporter for the Boston Traveler, had been a writer of note since 1920. Probably her most famous book was "Young Man of Manhattan," published in 1930.

Mrs. Brush had nearly completed a novel when she became ill. It would have been her first novel since "This Man and This Woman," published in 1944. She is survived by a son, Thomas Stewart Brush, and a brother, Thomas Ingham.

### SS United States Fastest Ship Afloat

Newport News, Va. —(U.P.)— America hailed her new luxury superliner, the SS United States, as the fastest big ship afloat Wednesday following the sleek vessel's first Atlantic speed trial.

U. S. maritime officials said the 990-foot ship, biggest of the nation's merchant fleet, proved herself capable of "considerably" exceeding 34 knots in test runs off the Virginia coast Monday and Tuesday.
