Copco Undecided On Tax Write-Offs California Oregon Power company officials said today that the company's directors have not yet decided whether it will take advantage of rapid tax amortization allowances recently granted by the Defense Electric Power Administration.

It was announced in Washington, D.C., yesterday that a total of \$38,200,000 in power plant and transmission line construction has been approved for tax write-off within five years, rather than the normal depreciation period of 25 years.

The power facilities covered by the Copco certificate include those at Soda Springs, Fish Creek, Clearwater Nos. 1 and 2, Lemolo Nos. 1 and 2, and Crescent City, according to the United Press.

Copco officials explained that the situation regarding the tax amortization procedure, as governed by the Public Utilities commissions of Oregon and California, has not been cleared by policies adopted by the two bodies and that a decision on whether or not the write-off will be used depends on a clarification by the PUCs.
