FAMILY DOCTOR IN THE TWENTIETH CENTURY

For fourteen years before I began quacking in the public prints I tried with all my heart and soul to be a bona fide family doctor, the like of which I'm afraid there are not many left. For the first ten years—well, when I recall what my family had to endure in those ten years, from the very people I tried so hard to serve, I can't feel bitter about it and you may have noticed this between the lines of this column.

Dr. Oliver Wendell Holmes's Autocrat and Professor sketches, originally published serially in New England magazines suggested that I might possibly supplement my income by writing for the magazines and so continue my career as a family doctor for the love of it. I have been grateful to the doctor-poet-philosopher ever since. Had it not been for the inspiration I got from these two little volumes (mine are the Everyman's Library editions, 35c each, remember, old timers?), I might have made a good salesman or clerk.

For six years I kept literally dozens of manuscripts in the mail—the postage bill was a formidable one. I can assure you—but eventually the magazines began to accept occasional articles and pay for them.

Then one day there came in the mail a little magazine for writers called The Editor (not published now), which listed markets for manuscripts. Among the markets was one called a Newspaper Syndicate—the first I had ever heard of such an institution. I sent the syndicate 2 1/2 dozen short health articles suitable for daily newspaper publication. The syndicate signed me to conduct a daily health column which was launched in some twenty or twenty-five papers at first—and, believe it or not, some of the pioneers still print selections from the copy I provide daily.

There are few family doctors left because people don't care so much for the truth as they do for the gadgets and machinery of the trick "specialists" and "clinic" racketeers who are so much more efficient in separating the wisecrack customers from their easy come, easy go money.

Reverting to my own unhappy experience in trying to be a bona fide family physician, I must say
