**LOVE IS STILL LOVE, NO MATTER HOW EXPRESSED**

No two people express the same emotion in the same way. When a person is angry, he may hit or kick, he may throw anything within his grasp, he may shout and scream, or he may be quiet and sulky. So it is with love. This young wife finds it hard to accept her husband's restrained emotions and asks:

(Q) "How can I make my husband show me he loves me? I feel that something is missing in my marriage. My husband seems unable to show his love for me. He comes from a broken home and he has built up a wall around himself as if to protect his emotions. I love him deeply and I show it. I know he loves me but I like to be told so and to have him hug and kiss me just because he loves me. Am I wrong in wanting and needing these little acts of tenderness?"

(A) It is natural for a demonstrative person — and that is what you are — to want the person she loves to react to her as she does to him. But it doesn't always work out that way. You have selected a man who is as restrained as you are demonstrative.

It's fortunate you know the cause of your husband's restraint and don't think it means lack of love on his part. It is natural for him to be as he is after an unfortunate childhood. He is defending himself against further emotional hurts. Furthermore, many men are embarrassed about showing their emotions too openly.

Keep on being yourself and let your husband be himself. Never make the mistake of showing him that you are hurt when he is not demonstrative or ask him to express his love more openly. This would embarrass him and make him build a higher wall to protect himself from fur-

### Military Program For Construction Receives House OK

Washington — (AP) — The House has approved a military construction program which includes secret work at overseas air bases from which American atomic bombers could "saturate" Russia within a few days in event of war.

The bill was passed on a roll call vote, 332 to 7.

As cleared by the House and sent to the Senate, the building plans call for an outlay of \$2,758,318,000 by Army, Navy and Air Force, at about 250 bases in this country and around much of the rest of the world.

The bill authorizes an outlay of \$383,291,000 by the Army and \$285,750,000 by the Navy. The bulk of this work is listed in the legislation. It covers expansion, improvement and reactivation of bases in this country and abroad.

Included in the projects as approved by the House, are: Oregon, \$973,000; Air Force, Portland International Airport, \$973,000.

### Ashland Rotarians Visit Experiment Station Yesterday

About 60 members of the Ashland Rotary club and guests yesterday observed the various experiments being made at the Southern Oregon branch experiment station, agronomic division, located near Talent. Harold H. White, agronomist in charge of research in farm crops conducted the group about the farms.

Several Medford guests were with the group, including Mayor D. L. Flynn, John Cotton, Ashland, is president of the Ashland group. Before making the tour of the farm crops the group ate a box lunch at the station.

They observed experiments being made on grain, seed and pasture grasses, some 46 varieties of alfalfa being grown for seed and hay; effects of chemical control on weeds; sorghum testing for ensilage purposes; fertilizer experiments and numerous other projects being conducted. Experiments at the station are designed to meet the needs of the Southern Oregon farmers, White pointed out.

A general farmers' field day will be held at the experimental farm Thursday, June 19.
