WHAT MAKES JERRY GROW?

You children who have studied your little lessons — you know, Little Lessons in the Ways of Health — know, by now, I hope, at least these elementary facts:

1. To insure health, vte and functional efficiency every growin g child must assimilate not less than a gram (about 15 grains or a quarter of a teaspoonful) of calcium (lime) every day.
