Your Health and Its Care

PRESENT STATE OF THE BABY BUSINESS In my practice as an international quack I get a general view of the state of the baby business, and from this survey I feel qualified to make these observations: 1. Doctors, druggists, nurses, neighborhood sairey-gamps and parents today do not make a practice of dopping babies with opium (that is, laudanum, paregoric, cough syrups, colic cures) as they did when you and I were toddlers.

2. Nowadays parents who are not morons give their babies a break in the way of cleanliness, fresh air, light and comfortable clothing and bed-covers or none if weather and common sense so indicate, pure wholesome food and protection against unsolicited advice by interfering neighbors and relatives.

3. Improvement in the business is slow because so many American parents, politicians and educators remain unconvinced that instruction in infant care and feeding should be requisite for entrance to high school. In Yankeeland it

is desirable that children learn how to drive an automobile but not quite proper that they should learn how to bathe, feed and dress a baby. This reluctance to teach future parents how to care for their children is not just squeamishness, but largely an attitude determined by the price of sugar.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS Knee Ache After the birth of my last baby my knees ached. Our doctor prescribed therapeutic vitamins but they didn't help. One day I read in your column about calcium and D. After taking calcium and D for several weeks my knees quit aching. (Mrs. L. S.) Answer—Whether that is coincidental or not, calcium deficiency is aggravated by the demands of the growing fetus, and so it is advisable to increase the calcium and D intake during pregnancy and for a year after childbirth, especially if the baby is nursed.
