MAGNESIA NOT GOOD FOR CHILDREN

Is it advisable to put milk of doses of milk of magnesia are baby gets every day? Four

The best way to deprive the body of calcium is to give magnesium (milk of magnesia, Epsom salts), according to one authority (Meltzer), and other authorities (Mendel, Benedict) have shown that magnesium forces calcium from the system.

Heaven knows most of us suffer from calcium deficiency anyway.

Bastedo, another recognized authority, says:

"It would seem that there must be danger in the repeated administration of magnesia, at least to children or to those with fractured bones or bad teeth."

The conductor of this health service, who is no authority about anything, would add to Bastedo's statement—

"...or to those with chronic rheumatiz, adult tetany (as manifested by painful nocturnal leg cramps) or C.V.D."

It was the routine practice in the nineteenth century to use lime water in the "formula" for making up the baby's food, usually a fluidounce of it to the mixture for the day. This, as some eminent specialist opined, prevented the formation of large curds in the digestive tract—and curdling of milk (which is actually a normal part of the digestive process) obviously accounted for "intestinal indigestion," "colic," "constipation" and other infantile complaints which were more likely due to wrong feeding and/or unnatural interference — with anemias, castor oil, etc.

Milk of magnesia is a mixture of suspension of magnesium hydroxide in water. Lime water is a solution of calcium hydroxide in water. Magnesium hydroxide (hydrate) is a stronger alkali or antacid than calcium hydroxide and it has laxative or cathartic action which lime water has not.
