Learned From Pictures

Corinne learned all about western life when nothing but American westerns were shown in French theaters after the war.

"When I first came to these country I thought everybody was a cowboy walking down the streets," she said. "Lots of Europeans think that."

Corinne plays a French girl in "Powder River" at 20th Century Fox, but she doesn't think her countrymen will approve of the role.

"They never do," she said. "American movies always show French people as sexy. But French people are so much like that they don't believe they are like that."

"Sex is what we French have most on our mind. Here in these country, eh! Everybody trying to make money."

(jaw) is not the only fatal happening that may be mistaken for rabies. In one instance a young child left alone for a few hours suddenly began to have convulsions and died in about 12 hours. The health department attributed the death to rabies—it seemed the child had played with a stray dog a few weeks before the tragedy struck. But I am morally certain that the child died of strychnine poisoning—strychnine in sugar coated pills left in a dresser drawer within the child's reach.

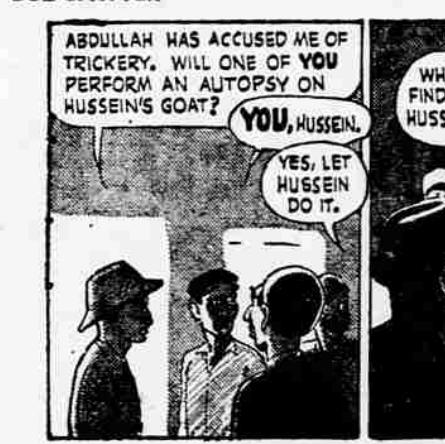
