

Range Reseeding Tour Slated for August 25 to 27

A range tour of several reseeded areas in Jackson county has been scheduled August 25, 26 and 27, according to W. B. Tucker, county extension agent. The tour will begin at 8:30 p.m. Monday, August 25, at the courthouse. The Anderson Ridge experiment station west of Talent, the Yale Creek skidroad reseeded plot and the Silver Fork range reseeded area will be visited that day.

Stay at Union Creek

Tuesday the Little Elk range reseeded plot, the skidroad reseeded area near Fish lake and the Willow prairie range reseeded plot will be visited. The group will remain overnight at Union Creek. Wednesday they will view the Flat Creek range reseeded plot, the Sams Camp range area and Bruce Grieve's reseeded plot on the Graham Creek road.

Tucker said anyone who is interested in improved range and forestlands is invited to attend, but he asked that they contact the extension office or the Rogue River National forest office. The tour is jointly sponsored by the forest service, the bureau of land management and the Jackson County Stockmen's association.

Atlantic City, N.J. — (U.P.) — The executive council of the American Federation of Labor, in a precedent-shattering move, laid the groundwork Thursday for endorsement of a presidential candidate.

It would be the first time in 28 years and the second time in the labor organization's 71 year history that it has actively supported a candidate for the presidency.

"With all good wishes, sincerely, Richard Nixon." Manno met Nixon when he was a member of the international board of trustees of the 20-30 club from 1938-42 and Nixon was president of the Whittier, Calif., club. Later the two became better acquainted at the 20-30 national conventions held in San Francisco and San Diego.

Barbara Giron, stewardess on the flight, said Mrs. Serpa told her at midnight that she was having pains. But the pregnant woman, whose husband was scheduled to meet her at the airport in New York, said she wasn't worried because the baby was not due for two more months.

To Ask Reversal Of Pelton Order

Portland — (U.P.) — The Portland General Electric Co. said Thursday it would ask that the recent order by the Oregon State Hydroelectric commission denying it the right to build the controversial Pelton dam on the Deschutes river be set aside.

A company official said the firm would file with the commission an application for a public hearing on the company's application for the permit. The company claimed the commission should have conducted a public hearing before turning down the original application.

The Pelton dam is opposed by commercial and sport fishermen, who claim it would destroy fish life on the Deschutes.
