Hollywood — (U.P.) — Eddie Cantor, who pushed Dinah Shore to success, decided today the new crop of female vocalists, except for one, are "imitations."

Back in 1939 the big-eyed television and radio comedian discovered Dinah singing with Xavier Cugat and put her on the map via his radio show. He calls her "the most natural singer since Nora Bayes."

"Dinah sings like Dinah Shore," he said. "But these new girls today — they're carbon copies of Dinah and Leona Horne. They have no individuality."

"The only one I pick for stardom is Connie Russell. She started on my show, and now she has her own show. I think she'll be another great name in show business."

Cantor found it easier to select the males who he thinks will climb the ladder. In fact, he said, this year produced the biggest crop of new entertainers in 10 years because television is replacing vaudeville as a showcase for them.

He said TV-comic Red Buttons is barreling along to becoming one of the all-time great comedians.

"I remember when he was playing the borscht biscuit in the Catskill mountains," said Cantor. "He used to cry on my shoulder until my lapel would

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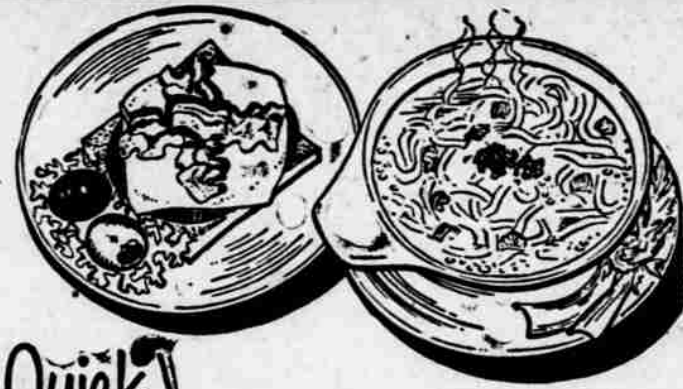

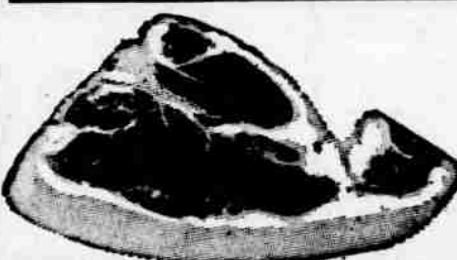
