As recently as four months ago Gayla had never made a professional appearance. She was a quiet little fifth grade school girl who jumped rope, played jacks and sang for the fun of singing.

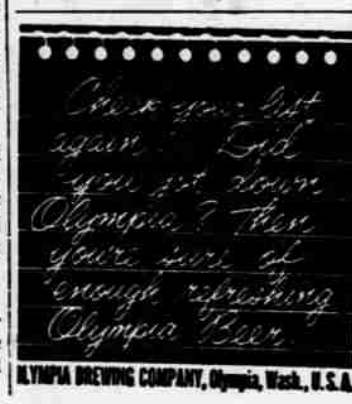
