A Nichol's Worth of ... Comment On This and That

Washington — (U.P.) — Stuart Little thought that what the world needed more than anything else was a booklet on crows.

So he wrote many of his friends including me, asking for crow anecdotes. Little wishes that he hadn't. He got a lot of crow talk, of course, but what was worse he got a lot of live crows. All mean critters. They are all over his rather smallish quarters at 5th avenue and 42nd street in New York City. If our man is unhappy, his secretary, Ann Prokopowicz, is thrice as miserable.

Being a crow sitter is not in Ann's contract, she says. And

she is frank to admit she's about to fly the coop.

A guy in Plainfield, N. J., sent Little a cantankerous black fellow named James. James took an immediate dislike to Little and drove same home with a hard nip to the Little nose.

Little got a lot of other crows, too, but no cages to put them in.

He also got some of the crow stuff that comes in bottles which wasn't so bad.

Along with the feathered pets he actually did get some anecdotes. None of which he believes.

A sportsman from Lebanon, Pa., lightened Little's load somewhat by sending a crow call.

"He suggested that if I wanted to know all about crows I should run out on Fifth Avenue and tootle," he said. "I have tootle myself black in the face but the only crows I get are dumb birds which come collect."

National Lawyers Guild Placed on Subversives List

Boston—(U.P.)—Attorney General Herbert Brownell Jr., announced today he intends to put the National Lawyers Guild on his official list of subversive organizations.

In a speech before the American Bar Association, he said the Justice Department has unearthed evidence to show that the 16-year-old guild is now "a Communist dominated and controlled organization fully committed to the Communist party line."

In Hands of Communists

"It has been clear," he said, "that at least since 1946, the leadership of the guild has been in the hands of card carrying Communists and prominent fellow travelers."

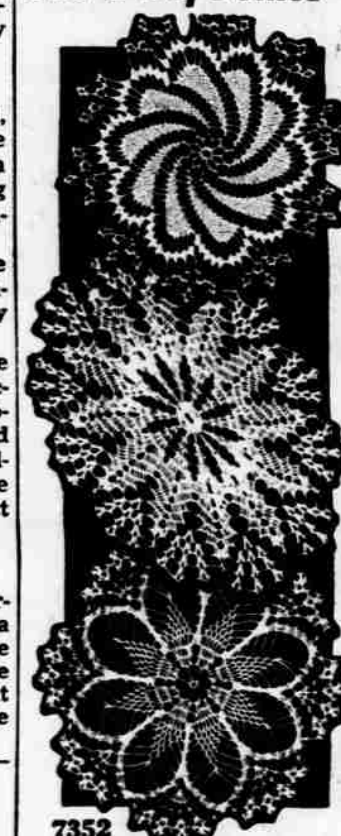
He said the guild "has become more and more the legal mouthpiece for the Communist party and its members."

Brownell told the ABA that he has notified the guild that, in accordance with his newly established procedure, it is entitled to a hearing before being formally added to the list of subversive organizations as a Communist front.
