

CAA Decision To Vacate La Grande Station Questioned

La Grande—(U.P.)—A member of the House Appropriations committee has questioned the Civil Aeronautics Administration plan to close the La Grande CAA communications station.

In testimony here yesterday, Rep. Sam Coon, who arrived in an ambulance after a recent minor operation, said the committee did not mean to sacrifice safety in any way. Numerous witnesses at the four-hour hearing had made the point that the La Grande station is necessary for air safety.

"I defy any man in the CAA to say that the committee cut their budget so much as to sacrifice safety in any way," Coon said.

A transcript of the hearing will be sent to CAA regional headquarters at Los Angeles.

Art Johnson, chief of Airways division for the region, said the CAA plans on cutting its expenses, following a cut in CAA funds by Congress, by making the 1954-55 budget even smaller than this year.

Johnson emphasized that the final decision to close the station has not been made.

Coon stayed at the hearing about an hour, despite doctor's orders to remain only 15 or 20 minutes.

Morse Calls for Western Meeting

Toronto—(U.P.)—Sen. Wayne Morse (Ind.-Ore.) has called for a top level meeting of the western nations before the Korean peace negotiations start.

"The Allies should get together, find out what our differences are and what agreements we can reach to narrow the area of disagreement," he said.

"The heads of states or their foreign ministers ought to come to an agreement. Charges and counter charges thrown across the Atlantic are not the way to reach agreement."

The senator, speaking at the international convention of the Amalgamated Lithographers of America, also advocated a U.S.-Red China conference to see if the Peiping regime really means peace and "whether they are going to fish or just cut bait."
