A Nichol's Worth of ... Comment On This and That

Washington — (UP) — Fred Wheeler has brought back some interesting observations from a mission to Peru. He says that Peru claims to have developed the Irish potato.



"Some visiting Chinese," he said, "is believed to have invented the Irish stew, although I understand there are a few challenges on this from other parts of the world."

All of this was interesting to Wheeler, whose business is to know all about things that come from the good earth. He has spent the last two years in Peru with a field party of the Bureau of Inter-American Affairs. His job has been that of a dungaree diplomat, a representative of the State Department who helps Peruvian farmers to help themselves in an agricultural and natural resource development program. The program has been under way for 10 years and will continue.

Wheeler, who will return to his Peruvian assignment shortly made it clear that the project is not a "giveaway."

"We're just there to help," he said. "The Peruvian farmers buy their own machinery. We help them to improve their grazing lands and their herds and flocks. We are getting them away from the oxen and onto tractors and threshing machines. Our main object is to help the farmers to increase their food production."

Peru provides most of the funds for the work, while the U. S. representatives "stand by and give advice, and even do some of the work—in dungarees."

The program embraces just about everything that grows there. Cattle, sheep, poultry, and in the fields, sugar cane, cotton, corn, potatoes (Irish, of course), beans and many kinds of pro-
