Safety Council Stresses Safety of School Children

Traffic safety for school children is the theme of the Medford Safety Council for September. Careful driving as schools open was stressed at the meeting of the council held Friday at the Jackson hotel.

To Give Pamphlets
It was announced that Boy Scouts were to hand out pamphlets on safety in behalf of school children on the Medford

streets Saturday. "Please, Mr. Motorist: Remember every child along the street is a human caution sign!" is the plea contained in the leaflet which urges that motorists help all children grow up.

School safety is tied in with traffic and drivers must watch at all times to protect the lives of boys and girls, particularly in the school areas, it was pointed out by E. T. Anderson, chairman. While the training of children in safe practices begins at home, drivers of automobiles and trucks must be ever vigilant to prevent children from being injured on streets or at crossings when they forget or pay no heed to their training.

Traffic laws are those most frequently violated in America these days, and it is there that safety must be constantly practiced, council members said.

WYANT-OWNED COW COUNTY'S LEADING BUTTERFAT PRODUCER

Elinor, a cow of the R. L. Wyant and Son herd, was top butterfat producer during August, a summary of the Jackson County Dairy Herd Improvement association shows. The animal produced 1,445 pounds of milk with 89.6 pounds of butterfat in 46 days of production.

Top herd of the month was that of C. W. Jensen with 21 cows averaging 848 pounds of milk and 42.6 pounds of butterfat, with four cows dry. Don Ullom's 26-animal herd with four dry, produced an average of 811 pounds of milk and 38.3 pounds of butterfat. The R. L. Wyant and Son herd of 29, with eight dry, produced 674 and 36.9. Russell Johnson recorded 905 and 36.2 with 55 cows, six of them dry.

Other top cows included Chet Jensen's Swiss with 1,556 pounds of milk, 84 pounds of butterfat in 39 days; Don Ullom's Peggy, 1,525, 83.9, 116; Wyant's Thorma, 1,597, 81.4, 57; Bill and Jo Hubbard's Mary, 1,891, 79.4, 49; Allen Rollins' Helen, 1,320, 79, 24; Richard Westerberg's Beta, 1,862, 78.5, 78; Don Geron's Number 21, 1,714, 77.1, 105; Minear Bros.' Spot, 1,925, 77, 82; Minear Bros.' Lucy, 1,702, 76.6, 39.

Hells Canyon Hearing Extension Turned Down

Washington — (UPI) — The Federal Power Commission has refused to extend the current recess in the Hells Canyon Dam hearing.

The hearing is scheduled to resume Sept. 21 on the proposal of the Idaho Power Co. to build three low dams on the Snake River on the Idaho-Oregon border.

The application is opposed by the National Hells Canyon Association, Inc., and several public utility districts, which favor construction by the Reclamation Bureau of a huge multipurpose dam at Hells Canyon.
