## IN DEFERENCE TO MR. MALONEY

In this column June 20 appeared this question and answer:

## BORIC ACID

Various physicians have prescribed boric acid, X-ray treatment, etc., without apparent benefit. Finally in the hospital they had me use cold boric acid packs. This relieved my dermatitis in short order. (H. B. F.)

Answer—Thank you. Such treatment is often effective, and, despite half-baked warnings against "poisoning" by boric

acid, perfectly safe whether skin is broken or not.

August 6, about to push into the chucker the six pounds of propaganda that reached my desk that day, I spotted one bundle that looked personal. It had 42 cents postage and typed in the corner was the name W. P. Maloney and a New York address.

Why, I wondered, should Mr. Maloney spend four bits to send me something?

In the accompanying letter, headed Public Relations, Mr. Maloney informs me that "one of the largest if not the largest manufacturer of baby boric acid has put in a rush order for new baby powder cans without boric acid or boric acid on the label, which means that boric acid has been removed from the product."

One enclosure is a reprint of a bulletin of the N. Y. City health department stating that several cases of boric acid poisoning have been reported and that the therapeutic value of boric acid is questionable. Since there are more efficacious and safer agents available, physicians in the child health stations are requested not to recommend the use of boric acid dressings on diaper rashes or other skin surfaces.

Three other enclosures are reprints of reports published in various medical journals describing fatal cases of boric acid.

poisoning of young infants from use of boric acid powder or boric acid on inflamed, irritated or excoriated skin surfaces.

Still another enclosure is a copy of a bill introduced in the General Assembly of Pennsylvania providing that boric acid or boric acid preparations (such as boric acid powder) shall not be sold unless the label states the amount or proportion of boric acid in the product and the word POISON is printed on the label in capital letters. This bill has not been enacted into law as yet, Mr. Maloney says.

Believe it or not I give up without even a jabber. What's more, I thank Mr. Maloney for putting all these convincing facts in my hands. I had missed two of the reports of fatal poisoning by boric acid.

I owe an apology to the corre-

spondent H. F. B., whose letter was destroyed when I answered the query, and to all other readers, as well as the physicians and health authorities who have proved to my satisfaction that boric acid is not safe as I have assumed it is. And just between myself and the corner of the wall I can tell you I don't enjoy eating that word of mine—"half-baked."
