

Six Oregon POWs Unaccounted for, Government States

Washington — (U.P.) — The Defense department Saturday released another list of American prisoners of war in Korea unaccounted for by the Communists.

The department said there is reason to believe the Communists hold or have information on the fate of these men.

The new list brings to a total of 917 the number of names released by the Pentagon. Still to be identified are 27 more men.

Portland Pair Die In Murder, Suicide

Portland — (U.P.) — A murder-suicide pact was blamed Saturday for the deaths of the young parents of two small children.

Bodies of John Lewis Day, 21, and his wife, Helen Lorraine, 19, were found shot to death in their apartment here. A .38 calibre service revolver was found beside Day's body. The Days were discovered when an employee of a funeral home where Day was employed as an escort rider went to the apartment to learn why he had not appeared for work.

Detectives said Day apparently shot his wife and then killed himself. A note, referred to as a "last will," was signed by both of them and requested only that they be buried together.

Authorities were unable immediately to learn a motive. Their children, John L. LeRoy, 18 months, and Jerry LeRoy, seven months, had been left with Day's parents, Mr. and Mrs. H. Day of The Dalles last Sunday.
