



## Ducks Have Best Running Grid Game

Los Angeles — Defense has taken over right where it left off in 1952 with UCLA and Southern California still leading the pack, it was disclosed today by the weekly statistics released from the office of the Pacific Coast Conference Commissioner.

Southern California has the highest ground defense while UCLA is tops in pass and total defense. The Bruins have allowed 92 yards a game rushing, followed by California, 126, and UCLA, 132.5.

UCLA has given up but 38.5 yards a game passing with Oregon, 73, and Stanford, 74, next in line. The Bruins have allowed 171 yards in total defense to 201 for Southern Cal and 244.5 for Oregon. UCLA also shares the lead with Washington in another defensive department, interceptions. Each has stolen four enemy aerials, the Bruins having returned for 54 yards and one touchdown.

### USC Most Yards

Oregon boasts the best running game and has averaged 239 yards per outing. Next comes UCLA, 236.5, and Southern Cal, 218.5. Washington's Huskies continue as the No. 1 aerial circus, with 173 yards a game on 24 completions in 61 throws. Washington State has averaged 116.5 and California 111.5.

Southern California has rolled up the most total yards on offense, 320 a game, 218.5 rushing and 101.5 passing. Behind the Bruins are UCLA, 295.5, and California, 285. UCLA also has the best punting average, 45.6 yards, on 10 kicks and has allowed enemies to return them only 20 yards. California has the best averages on kick returns, 19.0 on punts and 21.6 on kick-offs.

Two Conference games and five interconference are scheduled this weekend. UCLA and Oregon meet at Eugene and Washington and Oregon State in Seattle on Saturday afternoon. Southern Cal hosts Indiana Friday night and other Saturday afternoon games are: Ohio State at California, Stanford at Illinois, Washington State at Iowa and Idaho at Montana.

## B. Tebbetts To Skipper Cincinnati

New York — (U.P.) — Popular Birdie Tebbetts, brandishing a new two-year contract, stepped today into the job as manager of the Cincinnati Redlegs left vacant by the firing of Rogers Hornsby.

"The fans of Cincinnati will like Birdie Tebbetts," promised Redlegs' General Manager Gabe Paul after announcing the hiring of the former American League catcher.

Tebbetts, 42, is getting his first crack at managing in the major leagues after serving only a single season of apprenticeship as the pilot of a minor league team. He guided Indianapolis, a Cleveland Indian's farm team, to fourth place in the American Association this year.

The terms of Tebbetts' contract were not revealed, other than the fact it would run through the 1955 season.

Tebbetts, who lives in Nashua, N. H., said, "I am an optimist who hopes that the club will finish in the first division next season." That would be an improvement of at least two places from the Redlegs' sixth place finish this season.

The new skipper served more than 16 years as a catcher in the American League with the Detroit Tigers, Boston Red Sox, and Cleveland Indians, building up a reputation as one of the smartest handlers of pitchers in the business.
