Mrs. Dawson owns a black and white dog named Sprig. Sprig has learned to carry notes back and forth between the two sisters.

He spends the night at Mrs. Dawson's house, but in the morning he skedaddles over the ridge to Miss Amanda's place, taking a short cut through a hole in the 60-foot sandstone cliff that marks the top of the ridge. He follows around after Miss Amanda all day, but come sundown, he heads for home.

So well has this system worked that the sisters now have trained a cat to do the same job. It works out very conveniently for Mrs. Dawson, who is not well. If she wants anything from the store down at Nada, she just sends a note to her sister by dog mail.

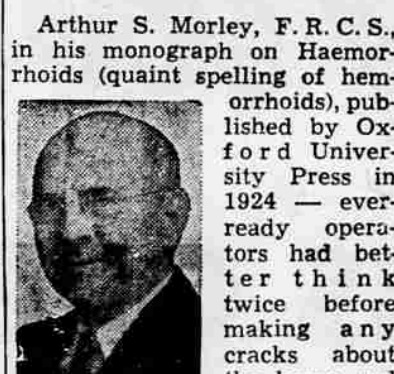

## TREATMENT OF A SURGEON'S PILES

Arthur S. Morley, F.R.C.S., in his monograph on Hemorrhoids (quaint spelling of hemorrhoids), published by Oxford University Press in 1924 — ever-ready operators had better think twice before making any cracks about the horse and buggy era.

Charley's damming with faint praise is typical of the way the old timers in medicine try to hold their practice against popu-

lar demand for new or improved methods.

He did not deign to explain why one could not call it a cure, nor did he venture to say that one could rail radical surgery (removal of ligature, clamp and cautery or the formidable excision of the entire pile-bearing area by what is called the Whitehead operation) a cure.

Morley treated 2,000 cases of internal hemorrhoids by injection at St. Mark's hospital in London and about 1,500 private cases in his office. That the results from injection compared favorably with the results his colleagues obtained from radical surgery was indicated by the fact that three of the house-surgeons, who had ample opportunities to observe both methods—that is, radical surgery and the ambulant (office) method—and compare them, became enthusiastic practitioners of the injection method, and one of them chose injection treatment for himself rather than submit to the (lamp

and cautery ordeal, which Sir Charles and other old timers prefer—for their victims.)

By the way, does Sir Charles Ryall or any other nineteenth-century surgeon, specialist, practitioner or authority in England or in America dare say that crushing and searing by cautery, removal by ligature or dissection by the Whitehead method cures piles? Probably not. That is an inference the shrewd ever-ready operators leave for the prospect to draw for himself.

The truth is that a simple, painless injection of a pile, which takes a minute or so in the doctor's office, obliterates that particular pile as positively as any other method can—but obliteration of one or more piles, by any means you choose, does not render the patient immune to development of the same varicose condition in one or more of

the numerous small veins of the area if the faulty hygiene that caused the trouble in the first place is not corrected.
