Catholic Parish To Collect Clothes

Used clothing, blankets, and shoes for Vietnam, Korea, and refugees in Europe and the Near and Far East will be collected by Sacred Heart of Jesus parish during the week of Nov. 21, it was announced Saturday by the Very Rev. Nicholas J. Dels, pastor of the church.

All parishes of the archdiocese of western Oregon are cooperating in a nationwide campaign under auspices of War Relief Services of the National Catholic Welfare conference.

All type of used but serviceable shoes, tied in pairs, are requested, as well as any kind of warm garments, knitted wear, blankets and bedding for persons of any age, including infants. They will be distributed free of charge through existing charitable agencies overseas.

If cash is contributed, checks should be made payable to "Thanksgiving Clothing Collection."

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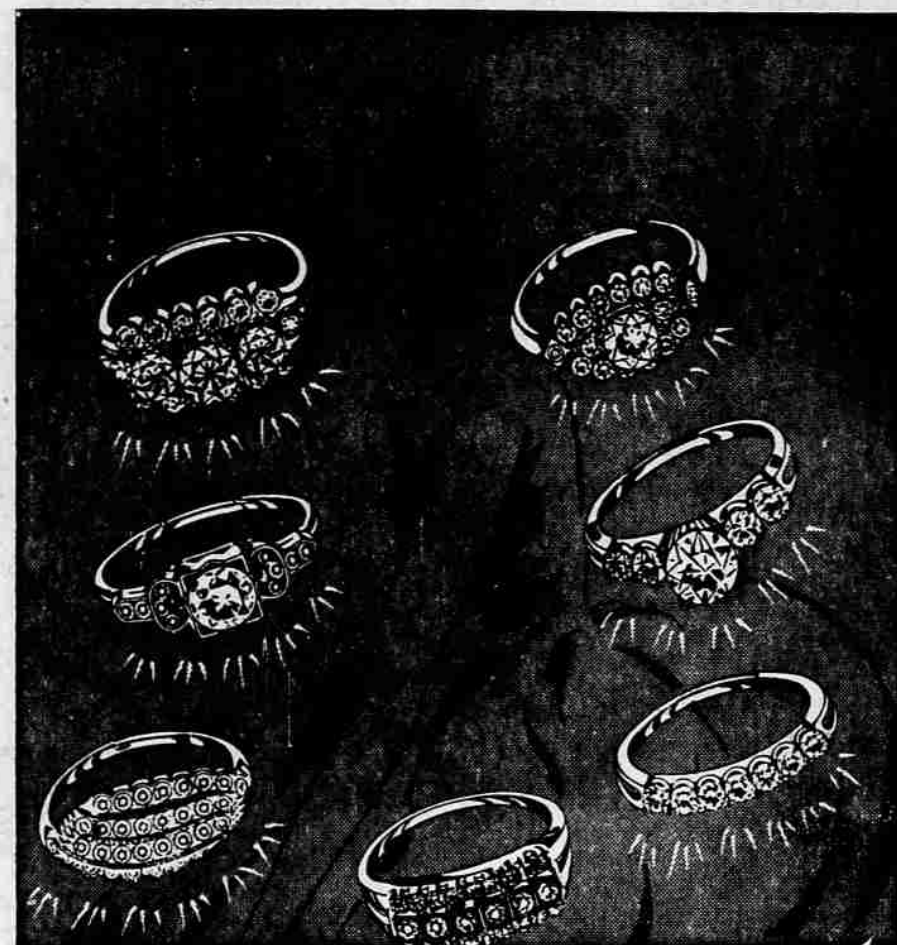
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
