

Russia's Signs of Desire for Peaceful Living Heads News

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The week's good and bad news on the international balance sheet:

THE GOOD

1. Soviet Russia shows signs of wanting a period of that "peaceful co-existence" of which it speaks. It is on the defensive in the cold war, with ratification of the treaties for West German armament virtually certain. The new trend first became apparent when Soviet Premier Georgi M. Malenkov suggested to the American Ambassador, Charles E. Bohlen on Nov. 7 that the big powers resort to old-fashioned secret diplomacy to keep international incidents from becoming big issues. Now Bohlen has been called home to consult with President Eisenhower and Secretary of State John Foster Dulles on the situation.

2. Seven Western powers led by the United States, Canada and Great Britain introduced in the United Nations a revised resolution to get President Eisenhower's "atoms for peace" plan started. The United States and Britain announced they would allocate fissionable material with which to operate experimental atomic power plants. Also in the U.N., a special committee started work on drafting a treaty for world disarmament. Months of work lay ahead, but the atmosphere was better than it had been because of Russia's apparently softer attitude.

3. The visit of Gen. J. Lawton Collins, President Eisenhower's special envoy, seemed to have improved the dangerous situation in Indochina. Collins threw American support behind Premier Ngo Dinh Diem of the state of Viet Nam, long involved in a cabinet crisis. In Korea, the United States signed a \$700,000,000 aid agreement with President Syngman Rhee's government. A long and bitter dispute over the exchange rate between United States and Korean currency was ended, in this country's favor.

THE BAD

1. The situation in East China sea became acute again when Chinese Communist torpedo boats sank a Nationalist destroyer escort vessel off the Nationalist-held Tachen Islands north of Formosa. Nationalist military authorities were worried over the possibility that the Reds might offer serious challenge to their blockade of the coast.

2. Algeria, Morocco and Tunisia in French North Africa seethed with unrest. "Army of God" rebels in Algeria continued a small scale war against French troops. In Morocco, Nationalist extremists forced a paralyzing general strike for three days. They threatened merchants with death unless they closed their shops.

3. Premier Shigeru Yoshida of Japan arrived home from his visit to the United States to face a determined attempt by politi-

cal opponents, including some of his own Liberals, to overthrow him. The test will come when Parliament meets Nov. 30. A defeat for Yoshida would be bad news for the United States, even though it was certain he would call a general election and appeal to the voters to elect a friendly Parliament.

Three Sabre Jets Collide; One Killed

George AFB, Calif. — (U.P.) — One pilot was killed and two parachuted to safety last night when three F86D Sabre jets collided in mid-air while on a night mission 10 miles north of here.

Identification of the victim was pending notification of next of kin, the Air Force said.

The two pilots who parachuted were identified as 1st Lt. Archie Ridall, Shippensburg, Pa., and Carl Fencher, Alta Vista, Kan.

Spokesmen said the third pilot had ejected himself from his burning plane, but apparently his parachute did not open. His body was found near the wreckage at Bell mountain.

Puerto Rican Enters Prison at Alcatraz

San Francisco — (U.P.) — Rafael Cancel Miranda, 24-year-old Puerto Rican who took part in the shooting of five congressmen last March, entered Alcatraz Prison Thursday night to serve a 25 to 65-year sentence.

"What I did, I did for the freedom of my country and the dignity of my people," Cancel Miranda said as he boarded the prison ferry for the island. "We want to call the attention of the world to the situation of our country and our aspirations to be a free nation."

Nearly Throws Away Winnings of \$28,000

Margate, England — (U.P.) — Tavernkeeper Alfred Sparrowhawk, 44, was about to throw a stack of mailed "advertisements" into the wastebasket when he decided to glance through them.

Among them was a check for \$28,000—his winnings in a football pool.

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
