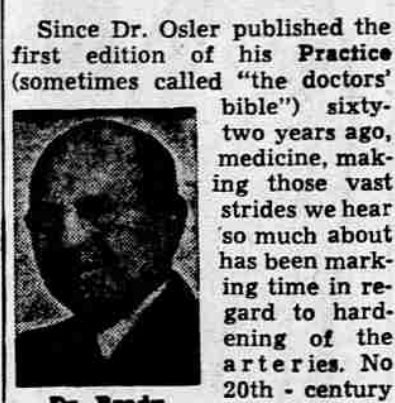

YOUR ARTERIES NICE AND SOFT?

Since Dr. Osler published the first edition of his *Practice* (sometimes called "the doctors' bible") sixty-two years ago, medicine, making those vast strides we hear so much about, has been marking time in regard to hardening of the arteries. No 20th-century authority has illuminated the question more than Osler did sixty years ago when he described arteriosclerosis as "the natural wear and tear to which the tubes" (arteries) "are subjected. Longevity is a vascular question, which has been well-expressed in the axiom that 'a man is as old as his arteries'."

Oh, yes, if you're a trusting soul, you can take various "shots" and follow freak diets which purport to reduce blood pressure.

Medical authorities from Osler to the present era have concealed their ignorance of the nature of arteriosclerosis as skillfully as they have of rheumatism, with scientific double talk.

A typical authority of Osler's era said that hypertension (high blood pressure) is the primary cause of arteriosclerosis, but he cautiously added that "some think the hypertension is secondary, a view substantiated by recent studies in pulse tension"—that is, the difference between systolic and diastolic blood pressure.

A typical authority of the present day clarifies the subject in a few well-chosen words (if any of you kids plan to study medicine, don't take this seriously):

"The term arteriosclerosis has today a stricter connotation than formerly... no longer comprises every lesion that causes" (probably the writer meant every thing other doctors regard as) "hardening of the arteries. Morphologically and pathogenetically" (remember what I told you, kids) "it is readily distinguishable from such lesions as" (hang onto your hats) "fatty infiltration of the arteries, syphilitic arteritis, bacterial and infectious arteritis" (hey, this is getting out

of hand—at least I, Brady, don't know the difference, if any, between bacterial and infectious) "endarteritis obliterans, thromboangitis obliterans (Buerger's disease, the alleged diseases from which arteriosclerosis is "readily distinguishable" are composed of horse feathers and hog Latin.

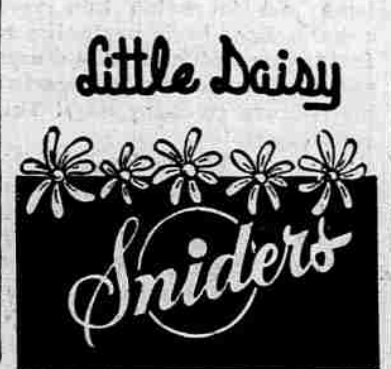
In the C.V.D. booklet, Buerger's disease receives three times as much space as high blood pressure does. Incidentally, let me warn you poor souls who are "trying" this or that treatment, diet or remedy for "high blood pressure" that the advice I give about it is: NEVER MIND YOUR BLOOD PRESSURE.

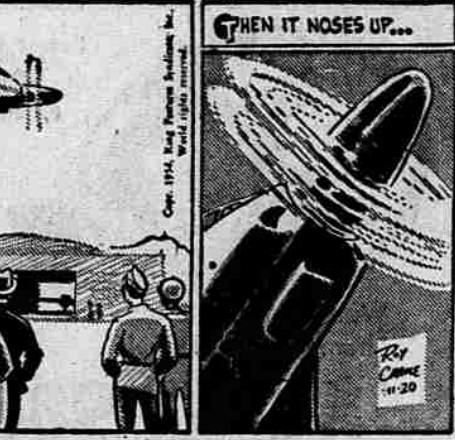
